In exercise of the powers under rule 8 of the Aircrafts Rules, 1937, **Station Managers / Airport Managers of all Airlines** are hereby permitted to allow the carriage of one licensed revolver or pistol or shotgun and fifty cartridges belonging to a bonafide passenger, provided that-

- the arms & ammunition shall be carried only in the registered baggage of the passenger;
- the registered baggage containing arms/ammunition shall be carried only in aircraft having separate cargo holds so as not to be accessible to passenger;
- the arms/ammunition are so packed, protected and secured as to avoid the possibility of their being a source of danger;
- the nature of the goods is clearly and conspicuously marked on the package containing them;
- the Station Manager / Airport Manager shall verify all the relevant documents to ensure that the arms are licensed in the name of the passenger concerned; and
- (M) the registered baggage shall be handed over to the passenger at the destination only in the arrival hall and not on the tarmac.
- 2. This permit is upto 31-12-2023.
