### AADENDUM TO IROSC TOURNAMENT CIRCULAR DTD. 17.09.2018

To,

All Shooters,

All State / District Rifle Associations / Clubs/ Units,

All Shooting Ranges / Schools / Colleges / Institutions.

**Sub: Staging of Indian Revenue Open Shooting Championship – 2018, in small bore Rifle/Pistol Events, at the Rana Institute of Sports Shooting (RISS), Vill - Mazhon, P.O. Poundha, via Prem Nagar, Dehradun (Uttarakhand), from 21<sup>st</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> of October, 2018.**

Dear Shooters,

In continuation to the earlier IROSC tournament circular dated 17.09.2018, we are pleased to announce the following:

1. Matches for Para shooters will also be conducted in the following categories (40 shots):
  - a. Match No. P-01 – 10M Air Rifle Standing Men (SH1) Individual.
  - b. Match No. P-02 - 10M Air Rifle Standing Women (SH1) Individual.
  - c. Match No. P-03 – 10M Air Pistol Men (SH1) Individual.
  - d. Match No. P-04 - 10M Air Pistol Women (SH1) Individual.
2. The entry fee for all the Para matches is Rs.500/- (Rs. Five Hundred).
3. **The Para shooters have to mention the Category as “Para” in the entry form and have to attach the “Medical Classification Certificate” issued by the PCI Medical Classifier along with the entry form.**
4. The category “A” and “B”, as given in earlier circular dated 17.09.2018, do not apply to the Para shooters.
5. The para events will be conducted along with the open category events.
6. There will be a “**Champion of Champions**” event in the Air Rifle and Air Pistol as follows:

**Category “A” –**

  1. Top 8 Air Rifle shooters (4 Men and 4 Women - Senior/Junior/Youth mix)
  2. Top 8 Air Pistol shooters (4 Men and 4 Women - Senior/Junior/Youth mix)

**Category “B” –**

  3. Top 8 Air Rifle shooters (4 Men and 4 Women - Senior/Junior/Youth mix)
  4. Top 8 Air Pistol shooters (4 Men and 4 Women - Senior/Junior/Youth mix)
7. In case any of the 8 top scoring shooter is not available for the COC then the next shooter will be eligible to compete in the COC.
8. The COC would be conducted on the last day of the tournament and the time of COC shall be announced during the course of the tournament.

9. The scoring in the COC will be non-decimal. In case of a tie, the winner will be decided by tie-shoot. The decision of the Organizing committee would be final.
10. **The 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners in Air Rifle and Air Pistol COC shall be awarded cash Prize of Rs.7000/- (Rs. Seven thousand), Rs.5000/- (Rs. Five thousand) and Rs. 3000/- respectively.**
11. **As regards the Category “A” and “B”, as give in the earlier circular dated 17.09.2018, it is again clarified that Shooters who have earlier participated in any ISSF category match of any particular event either in State/Zone championships or at Nationals are not permitted to participate in category “B” match of that particular event in this competition. They can only participate in Category “A” matches as category “B” matches are for beginner / new shooters. In case of mis-information given by the shooter, the shooter would be disqualified and debarred from the competition and the entry fees will be forfeited.**
