Olympic events in each category consist of Qualification and Final.

Individual and Team events will be conducted.

Maximum participation per Federation team is 3 shooters plus 2 MQS in each individual event.

The team and individual competition will be held if at least the team and individual comprises as follows.

a.	Men :	15 Individual and 5 teams
b.	Women :	10 individual and 4 team
C.	Men and Women Junior Youth	10 individual and 3 teams

Entries

All athletes participating in the 8th Asian Airgun Championship, New Delhi must have an ISSF ID number.

All shooters included in the Final Entry Form without an ISSF ID will not be entered in the competitions. Late 'issue' of an ISSF ID will be considered as a 'late entry' under ISSF Rules.

4. Rules and Regulations:

The competition will be conducted according to the ISSF and ASC Rules and Regulations.

Equipment control will be conducted according to the ISSF and ASC Rules and Regulations using instruments and devices approved by the ISSF.

5.Protests:

Any protest on the result of any competition must be submitted a maximum **10 minutes** after the announcement of the official results (Rule 6.15.4.1.1).

The protest fee is USD 50 and appeal fee is USD 100. If the protest is accepted, the payment will be refunded; otherwise the money will be retained by the Organisers.

Protests and appeals should be in writing, using ISSF Protest Forms (available from the Organisers).

6.Late Entries:

Late entries can only be allowed according to the ISSF rules. (Rule: 3.7.3).

Any Federation reducing the number of shooters/ or officials after the final entry deadline must pay all the applicable fees and costs including the entry fees according to the number of shooters and entries as indicated on the final entry forms originally received by the Organising Committee. If the applicable fees and costs are not paid, then no shooter of that Federation may participate in the Championship.

7. Entry Process:

Each Federation entering the competition must submit the necessary forms (Annexes 1 - 9) and submit them before the following deadlines. All forms are available on the ISSF Entry System (Federation access only).

8. Shooting Ranges:

The Competitions will take place at the Dr. Karni Singh Shooting Ranges, New Delhi.

The Olympic rifle and pistol ranges are equipped with Sius-Ascor electronic targets and scoring equipment.

The range comprises 10m – 80 firing points.

In addition, there is a separate Olympic Finals range.

9. Guns and Ammunition:

All information about shooters' Guns and Ammunition must be declared and sent not later than 26th August 2015 (Annex 8).

Please submit the form fully completed and signed and stamped by the Federation.

Please do not change the forms and do not use other forms. Incomplete or incorrect Forms will be returned, unprocessed.

All participating countries are advised to book their flight directly to Indira Gandhi International Airport, New Delhi. Reception and clearance of weapons will ONLY be arranged at the Indira Gandhi International Airport, New Delhi.

While in India, all guns and ammunition must be stored in the armoury at the shooting range. Delegations are advised that all teams and individuals/groups arriving separately should carry a signed and stamped copy of Annex 8 (Details Form for Guns and Ammunition) while both entering and departing India.

The storage of guns and ammunition in hotels and outside the shooting range is strictly prohibited. Armouries will be open to facilitate the arrival of official teams until departure.

10. Doping Control:

Doping Control will operate in accordance with WADA/ISSF/ASC Rules and Regulations under the supervision of an ISSF/OCA appointed medical anti-doping officer.

11. Ceremonies:

Medals' ceremonies will take place directly after the finals of each event.

All teams must bring one copy of their national anthem (CD) and (3) national flags (1x2 m) and deposit them with the Organising Committee during the team registration process.

12. Technical Meeting:

13. Entry Fees:

All payments must be cash in US Dollars (USD \$) to the Organising Committee upon arrival at the shooting complex. Payment using either credit or debit cards or travellers or bank cheques will NOT be accepted. Local banking facilities are available at New Delhi - details can be obtained from the Organisers.

14. Transportation/Airport:

Participating teams will be met and facilitated on arrival at Indira Gandhi International Airport at New Delhi. Teams will then clear immigration and security controls. Participants will be transported to the Dr. Karni Singh Shooting Ranges to deposit their guns and then taken to their hotels. Transportation to and from hotels to the Range will be arranged by the Organising Committee.

A transportation time table between the hotels and shooting complex will be available in the hotels.

Participating Federations should confirm their departure timetable with the Organisers (Annex 7) at least 48 hours prior to departure from New Delhi.

18. Equipment Control

Equipment control will be open to competitors as scheduled in the Programme for the Championships in accordance with ISSF Rules and Regulations.

19. Registration and Payments

Registration, confirmation of entries, payments for entries and accommodation fees MUST be made to the Organising Committee at the Registration Office at the shooting complex, on arrival. 'Start' numbers will only be issued after all accounts have been fully paid and receipted by the Organisers.

20. Exchange Rates and Local Currency

The currency of India is Indian Rupee. The exchange rate of the Indian Rupee to the USD \$ is approximately (1 USD = Rs. 60/-)

21. Media Relations

On site media facilities will be available for accredited media personnel. The event will be covered by local and national media.

22. Medical Services

During the competition, the Organisers will provide first aid and paramedical cover. A medical doctor will be in attendance during competition hours.
