

MODIFICATIONS IN SELECTION POLICIES 2018

The following amendments are made in the Selection Policies, which were approved by the Governing Body on 7th October 2017.

In view of the changes in rules by ISSF recently, the following new MQS have been fixed for Selection Trials/MTS. The new scores are only a pro-rata increase – proportionate increase of the originally approved score.

2. THE METHOD OF CALCULATION OF SCORES - for the purpose of ranking - UNTIL THE TABLE OF A DOMESTIC SHOOTER HAS SCORES SHOT IN TWO FORMATS.

In view of the new ISSF format for some events (increase in the number shots in the women's events), the NRAI will conduct all matches in the new format from 1st of January 2018. With this, the shooters will be having scores partly in the old format and partly in the new format.

To overcome this issue, it has been decided that until a shooter has the requisite number of scores in the new format - the scores achieved by the shooter in the new format should be reduced pro - rata to the old format (until the NRAI conducts 4 pistol/5 rifle domestic competitions in the new format)

.

This is illustrated as under:

Shooter "X" has two previous scores in old format and two scores in new format, which are to be considered for ranking.

Previous Score	370
61 NSCC Score	375
Trial 1 Score	560
Trial 2 Score	568

The trial scores are proposed to be reduced as under:

560/6	Average of each series	93.33×4	373.33
568/6	Average of each series	94.66×4	378.66

Scores will not be rounded off.

Therefore, the shooter "X" will have following four scores

370 375 373.33 379.66

Average of three high scores (for pistol) and four high scores (for rifle event) shall be considered for calculating the ranking for selection of National Squad, ISSF World Cups and Commonwealth Games. This procedure will continue until trial 3 & 4, due to be conducted in April 2018. By this time, the shooters participating in these trials will have four scores and international shooters will have more than four scores (after participation in WC and CWG).

This formula will be applicable for Women Air Rifle, Air Pistol and 50M Rifle 3P.

3. In view of the principal decision to have separate policies for Rifle, Pistol and Shotgun, a separate formula for calculating the average for ranking in Rifle events has been fixed as under:

The Average of the total of the highest four scores out of the preceding five scores.

Total of the Preceding Five Scores - (minus) 1 Lowest Score / 4 = Base Average Score
T of P5S - 1LS /4 = BAS

The advantage of deletion of the lowest score will be available to the shooter only if s / he has a minimum of 5 scores, within the stipulated time frame. If the shooter has only 4 scores then all 4 scores will be required for the

calculation of MAM [no deletion will be allowed]. A shooter who does not have 4 scores – within the stipulated time frame, cannot be considered for the purpose of ranking within this policy, except in extraordinary cases / circumstances.

If there are 2 identical lowest scores then only one will be deleted.

[While calculating each individual preceding score the score of the Finals [as per chart 1A] - if any - will be added to the Qualification Score.]

FINAL AVERAGE SCORE [FAS] = Base Average Score + Merit Points

The Ranking of the shooter would be declared on the basis of the FAS

1b MAM for the Juniors / Youth shooters:

Until the completion of Selection Trial 4 / 4 NRC (2018) –

For the calculation of ranking of the Junior / Youth shooters the following formula will be applied:

Total of the Preceding **Four** Scores – (minus) **1** Lowest Score /3 = Base Average Score

$$T \text{ of } P4S - 1LS / 3 = BAS$$

Hence the Junior / Youth NSQ and selection of the teams for internationals will be selected on the basis of this formula until the completion of NRC 4 of 2018.

The general formula of the Average of the total of the highest four scores out of the preceding five scores will be applied for ranking the Junior / Youth shooters once 4 NRC are conducted by the NRAI.

4. It has been decided that ranking for women shotgun shooters, after conduct of two selection trials (January 2018), will be calculated on the basis of three scores shot during 61 NSCC (out of 75 birds) and two selection trials (out of 125). The selection of National Squad and international teams will be done on the basis of ranking achieved on basis of scores of these three scores.
