SUB: 1ST SHRI DIGVIJAY SINGH MEMORIAL SHOOTING CHAMPIONSHIP IN SHOTGUN EVENTS AT DR. KARNI SINGH SHOOTING RANGES, NEW DELHI FROM 25TH TO 31ST JULY, 2022.

Dear Sir,

The 1st Shri Digvijay Singh Memorial Shooting Championship in Shotgun Events will be held at Dr. Karni Singh Shooting Ranges, New Delhi, from 25th to 31st July, 2022 as per the program attached at **Annexure** "A". This will be organized by the National Rifle Association of India and conducted by Bihar State Rifle Association. The terms and conditions are as under:

1. PARTICIPATION

- a. Shooters who took part in 64th NSCC and have achieved MQS in ISSF matches as per rule 17.6 of NRAI Match Book 2018 (amended) are allowed to participate in this Championship. Copy of MQS is attached herewith for your ready reference at **Annexure "B"**
- b. Shooters, who are below 21 years as on 25th July, 2022, will be considered under the category of JUNIORS for the Championship. Juniors, who participated in 64 NSCC in junior category and are above 21 years of age now, will participate in senior category subject to them achieving MQS in junior category as per Clause 17.6 of NRAI Match Book 2018 (amended) during 64 NSCC.
- c. Those shooters, who have not received their Shooter ID number, must immediately visit our website www.thenrai.in to check status for their Shooter ID number.
- d. SHOOTERS, WHO ARE ALREADY IN POSSESSION OF SHOOTER ID, ARE NOT REQUIRED TO APPLY FOR FRESH ID REGISTRATION AND ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED ON EXISTING REGISTRATION.
- 2. List of the individual events is attached herewith as Annexure "C". The entries will be accepted through "NRAI'S ONLINE SYSTEM" and no paper entry will be received. These entries will be accepted on confirmation by the respective affiliated State Rifle Association/Units. The Shooters are required to visit our website www.thenrai.org to file their entries along with online payment of entry fee. The online entries

with normal fee will be accepted till 11.30 PM on 15th July, 2022. Late entries with triple entry fee will be accepted till 11.30 PM on 17th July, 2022.

- 3. Juniors can also participate in senior category with the payment of additional entry fee as per rules.
- 4. Entry fee will not be refunded except in the event of the match being cancelled. The entry fee should be paid "online" only and no cash/draft will be accepted.
- Shooters will be permitted to shoot only in the squads allotted to them. No requests regarding change of squads will be entertained.

6. TEAM REPRESENTATION

Team events will be conducted in accordance with Rule 18 of NRAI Match Book 2018 (amended). Only one Team from each State/ Unit will be allowed in each event irrespective of the number of participants in National Championship Category. Final entry of three members of the team must be submitted latest by 17.00 hrs. on the previous day of the start of that particular match.

7. PROTESTS AND APPEALS

The Protests and appeals will be dealt as per ISSF & NRAI Match Book 2018 (amended). The Protest fee is Rs. 200/- and in case of appeal to Jury of Appeal, the protest fee is Rs. 500/-.

8. AMMUNITION

a. The ammunition will be issued to the Team Manager only against cash payment on valid Arms Licenses of Associations/ Clubs/ Individuals or proper special permit issued by the Licensing Authorities. In case of inadequate authorization, special permits for the required quantity are obtained from the Local Licensing Authorities. Unused rounds and empties of used rounds are to be returned to NRAI without any exception.

9. GENERAL

- a. In extra ordinary circumstances, the Organizing Secretary may grant permission for use of a common weapon. The names of shooters likely to use common weapon should be advised together with the weapon number to the Organizing Secretary in advance to enable him to work out details for conduct of relevant matches.
- b. All participants are requested to go through the above instructions carefully and ensure strict compliance.
- c. All participants are expected to abide by the rules and regulations for the competition. Discipline on and off the field is very essential.
- d. In case of non-participation by the competitors after submission of their entries will not be allowed any refund of the Entry Fee.
- e. Shooting kit (clothing & Equipment) of the competitors during the competition will be strictly according to ISSF Rules.
- f. Shooting practice in hotels is strictly prohibited.

- g. The Organizers will have the right to close any match or event in case of any emergency or otherwise without assigning any reason for such an action on their part.
- h. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to amend the rules at any time at its sole discretion for events/circumstances beyond its control. Any decision made by the Organizing Committee in any such matter will be final. All participants are expected to abide by the rules and regulations for the competitions. Discipline on and off the field is very essential. Shooting practice in hotels is strictly prohibited.
- Scores of this Championship will be considered for selection of International teams under the Selection Policy.
- j. The scores as per score board/computerized score sheet, printed from the centralized scoring system installed at the range and shall only be valid. The Referees are required to make corrections, if any, on spot, during the round well before printing the score sheet. No correction is permissible once the printout has been taken."

k. COVID PROTOCOLS:

- Due to COVID 19 conditions, shooters are requested to strictly follow SOPs as laid down by Govt, of India/Delhi Govt.
- ii. All must carry Final Covid Caccination Certificate with them. In absence of Final Covid Vaccination Certificate, shooters/coaches must undergo a COVID-19 test prior to entering the range for training and submit a negative report from a Govt. certified lab to NRAI. This report should not be older than 48 hours from the date of your first entry at the range.
- iv. Only one person will be allowed to accompany the shooter subject to production of valid negative COVID 19 reports.
