GENERAL REGULATIONS

1. ORGANIZERS

The National Rifle Association of India shall be organizing and conducting the 67th National Shooting Championship Competitions (NSCC) in Pistol Events in accordance with the rules of ISSF, NRAI Match Book and. The rules are available on the websites of ISSF and NRAI.

2. VENUE

The 67th National Shooting Championship Competitions (NSCC) in Pistol events will be held at Dr. Karni Singh Shooting Ranges, Tughlakabad, New Delhi from 13th December 2024 to 5th January, 2025.

3. SCHEDULE

Schedule is attached at Annexure “A”

4. PARTICIPATION

- a. Participation is open to competitors from State Rifle Associations/ Units affiliated to NRAI. In case where no State Rifle Association exists, competitors belonging to clubs directly affiliated with NRAI will be allowed to participate. NRAI members must take part through State Rifle Associations/ Units of their native place otherwise their entry will not be accepted. However, if there is no such Association / Club functioning in their State, they can take part as members of NRAI provided they have paid all their dues towards NRAI.
- b. State Rifle Associations/Units will allow the members of NRAI to participate in the competitions organized by NRAI without becoming a member of that State/Club to which he/she belongs subject to the member undertaking to follow all the rules and regulations applicable to the shooters of that State. The State Rifle Associations/units may also charge an additional fee equal to entry fee of the competition but not more than Rs. 5000/- for forwarding the entries of Life/Annual Members of NRAI. This is applicable when these shooters are not members of State/Unit or any District/club to which Members of NRAI wish to represent. The Members of NRAI must have achieved MQS as defined for each competition under NRAI Match Book





5. AGE CRITERIA

Shooters, who are completing the age, as stated below in 2024, will be allowed to participate under age categories matches:

Juniors – 21 years	Born in 2003 or after.
Youth - 19 years or before	Born in 2005 or after
Sub Youth - 16 years or before	Born in 2008 or after
Masters – 45 -- 60 years	Should have completed 45 years one day before Competition
Senior Masters – 60 – 70 years	Should have completed 60 years one day before Competition
Super Masters – 70 years	Should have completed 70 years one day before Competition

SHOOTERS BELOW THE AGE OF 12 YEARS AS ON FIRST DAY OF THE COMPETITION ARE NOT ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN FIREARM EVENTS DURING THIS CHAMPIONSHIP.

6. ENTRY

Those shooters, who have not received/ applied for their Shooter ID number, must immediately visit our website www.thenrai.in to check status/apply for their Shooter ID number.

SHOOTERS, WHO ARE ALREADY IN POSSESSION OF SHOOTER ID, ARE NOT REQUIRED TO APPLY FOR FRESH ID REGISTRATION AND ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED ON EXISTING REGISTRATION.

The entries will be accepted through respective affiliated State Rifle Association/Units only. Entries will only be accepted through “NRAI’s ONLINE SYSTEM” and no paper entry will be accepted. **The Shooters are required to visit our website www.thenrai.org to file their entries along with online payment of entry fee. The online entries with normal fee will be accepted till 7.30 PM on 26th November, 2024. Late entries with triple entry fee will be accepted till 07.30 PM on 29th November, 2024.**

In the case of shooter, who qualify on the basis of performance in 26th All India Kumar Surendra Singh Inter School Shooting Championship, entries with single fee will be accepted till 8th December, 2024 and with triple fee till 10th December, 2024

The NRAI reserve the right to accept entries after this date as per clause 6.3 of NRAI Match book, subject to the availability of the details/lanes.

- Please note that it takes 72 hours for your entry to reach on NRAI system, hence shooters should not contact or send email to NRAI immediately after filing their entries. It is informed that the State Rifle Associations have the right to reject your entry within 72 hours.
- Shooters may send email to NRAI office for any assistance in case any issue related to filing of entry on email ID indiashooting@gmail.com
- Juniors, Youth and Sub Youth shooters can also participate in senior category with the payment of additional entry fee as per rules.





7. MEDALS

Individual and Team medals will be awarded as under:-

3 medals where there is a minimum of 4 entries.

2 medals where there is a minimum of 3 entries.

1 medal where there is a minimum of 2 entries.

No medal in case there is a singly entry.

Foreign Nationals may be awarded souvenirs

Senior and Super master's category shooters are exempted from above.

8. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR 67th NSCC:-

Shooters who took part in the following Championships and have achieved qualifying scores as per Rule 17.6 of NRAI Match Book are allowed to participated in this championship:

1. 65^h/66th NSCC
2. Zonal Championships 2024
3. 33rd AIGVMSC 2024
4. India Open Competitions 2024

Shooters furnishing incorrect information shall be Debarred from taking part in any Shooting championship/competition for Two years including blocking the Shooter ID account.

In case shooter is not qualified in a particular event and adds his/her entry that event on the portal of NRAI, a penalty of Rs. 5000/- (plus GST, as applicable) shall be imposed on the shooter and will not be allowed to participate in that event. The shooter will be allowed to participate in other events of the NSCC only after payment of penalty amount.

9. PARTICIPATION IN RAPID FIRE PISTOL (RFP) EVENTS

- a) A shooter of CFP / Std P / SP jr. M, who has achieved the scores stated below in any one of the events in the previous NSCC may participate in the RFP event at the NSCC.

- b) **Once a shooter has shot the RFP event at the NSCC and has achieved the MQS required as per 17.6, he would be eligible to shoot the RFP event in the next NSCC. If he fails to achieve the requisite MQS then he would have to take a break in next NSCC and can re-enter IN NEXT NSCC in RFP event as per clause 1 above. Clause 17.6.1 above will not be applicable for participation in Rapid Fire Pistol event**

d) PARTICIPATION BY WOMEN SHOOTERS (SENIOR AND JUNIOR) IN 50M PISTOL AND JUNIOR STANDARD PISTOLEVENTS

PARTICIPATION IN FREE PISTOL WOMEN (SENIOR AND JUNIOR) AND STANDARD PISTOL JUNIOR WOMEN EVENT IS SUBJECT TO RULE 17.13 OF NRAI MATCH BOOK.

10. a) Shooters, who achieve ISSF MQS as per Rule 17.6 of NRAI Match Book will be notified as “Renowned Shooter”.
b) Entry fee will not be refunded except in the event of the match being cancelled. The entry fee should be paid “online” only, and no cash/draft will be accepted. Shooters will be permitted to shoot in the details and lanes allotted to them. No requests regarding change of firing points/relays/dates will be REPLIED ON SUCH REQUESTS.





- c) Foreign Nationals must part in matches, specifically for Foreign Nationals and are not permitted to participate in National Championship matches. In case of any violation, the shooter will be disqualified from participation in this NSCC.
- d) DETAILS WILL BE PUBLISHED ON THE WEBSITE OF NRAI AFTER CLOSE OF ENTRIES (WITH TRIPLE FEE). No emails will be replied on this subject till the deadlines are over.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTION FOR DEAF SHOOTERS

Participation in Deaf category is restricted to shooters who are Deaf, defined as a hearing loss of at least 55 db PTA in the better ear (3-tone frequency average at 500, 1000 and 2000 Hertz, air conduction ISO 1969 Standard)

Shooters wanting to participate in Deaf category for the first time have to submit their Disability Certificate/Audiogram from Govt. Hospital for verification, to Ms. Anuja Jung at anujajung@gmail.com (9868206320 for WhatsApp message only).

Shooters whose certificates have already been verified and declared as eligible for Deaf Category, can submit their entries on NRAI's online System subject to the achieving MQS under NRAI, Match book.

MQS achieved in General category will also be considered as MQS for participation in Deaf category.

Shooters eligible to participate in Deaf category can also participate in other General categories as per their age group.

12. TEAM REPRESENTATION

Team events will be conducted in accordance with Rule 18 of NRAI Match Book. Only one Team from each State/ Unit will be allowed in each event irrespective of the number of participants in National Championship Category. Final entry of three members of the team must be submitted latest by 17.00 hrs. on our online portal www.thenrai.org.

NO MANUAL/PAPER ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED.





13. MIXED TEAM EVENTS

The Mixed Team events will be conducted as per ISSF Rules. All affiliated units which wish to enter must file their entries before **02.00 PM till 20th December, 2024 at NRAI Camp office at Dr. Karni Singh Shooting Ranges, New Delhi**. Only one team per category, consisting of one male and one female of the same state/unit, can be fielded. **Entry fee is Rs. 1500/- plus 18% GST = Rs.1770/-per team.**

14. PROTESTS AND APPEALS

The Protests and appeals will be dealt as per ISSF & NRAI Match Book. The Protest fee is Rs. 200/- plus 18% GST = Rs.236/- and in case of appeal to Jury of Appeal, the protest fee is Rs. 500/- plus 18% GST = Rs.590/-.

15. AMMUNITION

- a. The ammunition will be issued to the Team Manager only against cash payment on valid Arms Licenses of Associations/ Clubs/ Individuals or proper special permit issued by the Licensing Authorities. In case of inadequate authorization, special permits for the required quantity are obtained from the Local Licensing Authorities. Unused rounds and empties of used rounds are to be returned to NRAI without any exception.
- b. In extra ordinary circumstances, the Organizing Secretary may grant permission for use of a common weapon. The names of shooters likely to use common weapon should be advised together with the weapon number to the Organizing Secretary in advance to enable him to work out details for conduct of relevant matches.

16. ACCOMMODATION

Participants are requested to kindly make their own arrangements for accommodation. A wide range of hotels of all budgets are available in New Delhi.

17. GENERAL

- a) All participants are requested to go through the above instructions carefully and ensure strict compliance.
- b) All participants are expected to abide by the rules and regulations for the competition. Discipline on and off the field is very essential.
- c) Amount of Rs. 200/- plus 18% GST = Rs.236/-) will be charged if a shooter loses his/her competitor card during the competition and fresh card will only be issued on payment of duplicate card fee.
- d) In case of non-participation by the competitors after submission of their entries will not be allowed any refund of the Entry Fee.
- e) Shooting kit (clothing & Equipment) of the competitors during the competition will be strictly according to ISSF Rules.
- f) Shooting practice in hotels is strictly prohibited. In case of any violation, disciplinary action shall be initiated, and shooter may be debarred from taking part in NSCC.
- g) Accompanying person/personal coaches are not permitted to enter the Field of Play (FOP).
- h) The Organizers will have the right to close any match or event in case of any emergency or otherwise without assigning any reason for such an action on their part.





- i) The Organizing Committee reserves the right to amend the rules at any time at its sole discretion for events/circumstances beyond its control. Any decision made by the Organizing Committee in any such matter will be final. All participants are expected to abide by the rules and regulations for the competitions. Discipline on and off the field is very essential. Shooting practice in hotels is strictly prohibited.
- j) Scores of this NSCC will be considered for selection of National Squad and international teams under the Selection Criteria, which will be published before the start of the NSCC.
- k) The Selection of National Squad and international teams will be done in accordance with the Selection Policy.
- l) No request for any adjustment shall be entertained. The details of squads will be notified on the website of NRAI. Shooters are required to enter the range 90 minutes before the reporting time at range so that they can report on time for their detail. No reply shall be sent on requests for detail/lane adjustment.

18. All participating States/Units are required to nominate one Team Manager who will be responsible for drawing ammunition from NRAI and adjustment of lanes, if required.

19. WEAPON CARRY AUTHORITY LETTER – Shooters, travelling by air, can download Weapon Carry Authority letter from website www.thenrai.org after filing their entries. Shooters are requested not to send any email to NRAI and same will not be responded. In case shooters carrying more than one weapon and more than 50 rounds of ammunition, shooters are required to apply for DGCA permit by visiting the website of DGCA

20. COVID PROTOCOLS:

Due to COVID – 19 conditions, shooters are requested to strictly follow SOPs as laid down by Govt. of India/Delhi Govt. as and when in force.

21. CODE OF CONDUCT

- 1. Be a responsible human being and a committed sports person.
- 2. Be respectful towards fellow shooters, officials, Coaches, support staff and staff of NRAI.
- 3. Be punctual and diligent and adhere schedule timings.
- 4. Follow directions by officials.
- 5. Shall be dressed appropriately in a dress code prescribed by ISSF.
- 6. Be disciplined on and off the field.
- 7. Must not verbally abuse or intimidate in any form such as shouting making gesture, towards or in any other way distract any spectator, tournament official, technical official, opposing coach or opposing team official, or opposing player
- 8. Shall not indulge in any political or religious and other discourse/discussions.
- 9. Should not make any inappropriate or unwanted physical, verbal, or sexual advance towards anyone.
- 10. Adhere to rules as set by Govt. of India/Sports Authority of India/NRAI or any agency related to the Championship.
- 11. Shall abide by the Code of Ethics of ISSF.
- 12. Should not consume alcohol or tobacco at range.
- 13. It's the responsibility of the shooter to be aware of all the rules and be responsible for their equipment being as per ISSF regulations.





14. Shooter is responsible for following all rules/norms and go through the notices issued by NRAI at Range/Website of NRAI.
15. Adhere WADA/NADA rules and not to use drugs, which are not permitted under WADA/NADA rules.
16. In case of any grievance, please contact the Director of Competition, as per details given below.
Shall not interact with media in any form or over any print/electronic/social platform or post any material, which is contrary to the spirit of IOC Charter, ISSF Rules, shooting sport, fellow shooters, coaches, other office bearers of NRAI and against the policies of Govt. of India/SAI/NRAI.
17. Must not bring the shooting sport into disrepute through media that relate to tournament officials, technical officials, opposing coaches or team officials and or players, that are personal in nature, imply bias, or question their integrity.
18. Violation of above may lead to cancellation of entry of this Championship.
