SUB: XXIV KUMAR SURENDRA SINGH MEMORIAL SHOOTING CHAMPIONSHIP (IN RIFLE EVENTS) AT BHOPAL FROM 2ND to 15TH MAY, 2026

Dear Sir,

The XXIV Kumar Surendra Singh Memorial Shooting Championship in (Rifle events) will be held at Bhopal from 2nd to 15th May, 2026 as per the program attached at **Annexure “A”**. This will be organized and conducted by the National Rifle Association of India. athletes from your State/Unit are invited to participate in this Championship. The terms and conditions are as under:

1. Athletes who took part in 23rd KSS, 67th /68th NSCC and have achieved qualifying score as per rule 17.6 of NRAI Match Book are allowed to participate in this Championship. Copy of MQS is attached herewith for your ready reference at **Annexure “B”**. **IT MAY BE NOTED THAT THOSE PARTICIPANTS, WHO WISH TO PARTICIPATE ON THE BASIS OF THEIR PERFORMANCE IN 67th NSCC MUST HAVE ACHIEVED MQS PREVAILING AT THE TIME OF 67th NSCC.**
2. **PARTICIPATION, MATCHES, ENTRY FORM & FEE**
 - a. Participation is open to competitors from State Rifle Associations/ Units affiliated to NRAI as stated under para 1 above. NRAI members must take part through State Rifle Associations/ Units of their native place otherwise their entry will not be accepted. However, if there is no such Association / Club functioning in their State, they can take part as members of NRAI provided they have paid all their dues towards NRAI. State Rifle Associations/Units will allow the members of NRAI to participate in the competitions organized by NRAI without becoming a member of that State/Club to which he/she belongs subject to the member undertaking to follow all the rules and regulations applicable to the athletes of that State. The State Rifle Associations/units may also charge an additional fee equal to entry fee of the competition but not more than Rs. 5000/- for forwarding the entries of Life/Annual Members of NRAI. This is applicable when these athletes are not members of State/Unit or any District/club to which Members of NRAI wish to represent. The Members of NRAI must have achieved MQS as defined for each competition under NRAI Latest Match Book .
 - b. The competition will be conducted in individual and in team events. There will be no team event in junior/youth/Sub youth/Masters/Senior Masters/Super Masters/foreign national category. ATHLETES, who have taken part on wild card entry cannot be the member of teams. Furnishing wrong information in this regard would attract disqualification of team. Teams can be formed by the athletes of the same State/Unit only. Final entry of three members of the team must be submitted **online** latest by 1700 hours on the previous day of the start of the match. Only one team per State/Unit will be allowed in each event. The competition will be conducted in the events as per **Annexure “C”**.

- c. The entries will be accepted from respective affiliated State Rifle Association/Units through “NRAI’s ONLINE SYSTEM” and no paper entry will be accepted. The ATHLETES are required to visit our website www.thenrai.org to file their entries along with online payment of entry fee. The online entries with normal fee will be accepted till **07.30 PM on 7th April, 2026**. Late entries with triple entry fee will be accepted till **07.30 PM on 8th April, 2026**.
- d. Athletes may send email on indiashooting@gmail.com in case any assistance is required.
- e. Athletes, who are completing the age, as stated below in 2026, will be allowed to participate under age categories matches:

| Juniors – 21 years | Born in 2005 or after. |
| Youth - 19 years or before | Born in 2007 or after |
| Sub Youth - 16 years or before | Born in 2010 or after |
| Masters – 45 -- 60 years | Should have completed 45 years one day before Competition |
| Senior Masters – 60 – 70 years | Should have completed 60 years one day before Competition |
| Super Masters – 70 years & above | Should have completed 70 years one day before Competition. |

Juniors’ athletes may participate in Senior Category. The Youth athletes may participate in senior and junior category matches. The Sub Youth Category athletes are allowed to participate in all categories except Masters Senior Masters and Super masters matches.

ATHLETES BELOW THE AGE OF 12 YEARS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN FIRE ARM MATCHES DURING THIS CHAMPIONSHIP.

- f. Foreign Nationals must take part in matches, specifically for Foreign Nationals and are not permitted to participate in matches for Indian Nationals. In case of any violation, the ATHLETE will be disqualified from participation in this Championship.
- g. The ATHLETES are requested to download their competitor card/Equipment Control Sheet from our website www.thenrai.org as the same will not be issued at the shooting range.
3. **Scores achieved by the athletes during this Championship will be considered for selection of international teams as per Selection Criteria.**
4. Finals will be conducted in all Olympic events for SENIORS, JUNIORS and YOUTH.
5. **MIXED EVENTS**

The Mixed Air Rifle events will be conducted as per ISSF Rules. All affiliated units which wish to enter must file their entries before **2 PM on 2nd May, 2026**. Only one team, consisting of one male and one female of the same State/Unit, can be fielded.

MIX TEAM EVENTS ENTRY FEE Rs. 1500/- plus 18% GST = Rs.1770/- per team

- 10M Rifle Mixed Team (ISSF) Championship
- 10M Rifle Junior Mixed Team (ISSF) Championship
- 10M Rifle Youth Mixed Team (ISSF) Championship

7. Individual and Team medals will be awarded as under: -
- I 3 medals where there is a minimum of 4 entries.
 - II 2 medals where there is a minimum of 3 entries.
 - III 1 medal where there is a minimum of 2 entries.
 - IV No medal in case there is a singly entry.
 - V Foreign Nationals may be awarded souvenirs

Medals/Badges will not be awarded to those, whose score is less than the qualifying marks as prescribed for the relevant matches irrespective of their individual position. The grading of those securing above the qualifying marks will be done as usual. **This will not apply to the athletes under Deaf, Para, Senior Masters and Super Masters category. (AS PER RULE NO. 10.3 OF NRAI MATCH BOOK)**

8. Protest fee is Rs. 200/- (plus 18% GST = Rs.236/-) and in case an appeal is filed with the Jury of Appeal, then the fee is Rs. 500/- (plus 18% GST = Rs.590/-). The fee will be returned if the protest is upheld and retained by the Organizers if the protest is lost.
9. The competition will be conducted according to ISSF Rules and NRAI Match Book.
10. No arms will be provided to the competitors by NRAI. The ammunition will be issued to the Team Manager only against cash payment on valid Arms Licenses of Associations/ Clubs/ Individuals or proper special permit issued by the Licensing Authorities. In case of inadequate authorization, special permits for the required quantity are obtained from the Local licensing Authorities. Unused rounds and empties of used rounds are to be returned to NRAI without any exception. In extra ordinary circumstances, the Organizing Secretary may grant permission for use of a common weapon. Weapon details to be uploaded on portal of NRAI.
11. The Organizers will have the right to close any match or event in case of any emergency or otherwise without assigning any reason for such an action on their part.
12. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to amend the rules at any time at its sole discretion for events/circumstances beyond its control. Any decision made by the Organizing Committee in any such matter will be final. All participants are expected to abide by the rules and regulations for the competitions. Discipline on and off the field is very essential.
13. Shooting practice in hotels is strictly prohibited.
14. In case of non-participation by the competitors after submission of their entries will not be allowed any refund of the Entry Fee.
15. No request for any adjustment shall be entertained. The time and details will be notified on the website of NRAI. Athletes are required to enter the range 90 minutes before the reporting time at range so that they can report on time for their detail.
16. The Athletes/officials may contact the undersigned for any further information/details that may be required by them and might have not been covered by the above instructions.
