SUB: STAGING OF XXXII ALL INDIA G. V. MAVALANKAR SHOOTING CHAMPIONSHIP IN SHOTGUN EVENTS AT ARMY MARKSMANSHIP UNIT, MHOW FROM 3RD TO 10TH SEPTEMBER, 2023.

Dear Sir/Madam,

The XXXII All India G. V. Mavalankar Shooting Championship in Shotgun events will be held at Army Marksmanship Unit, The Infantry School, Mhow, Madhya Pradesh from 3rd to 10th September, 2023 as detailed in the program attached. This Championship will be conducted by Army Marksmanship Unit under the aegis of the National Rifle Association of India and as per rules and regulations under NRAI Match Book.

Those competitors, who want to participate in this Championship, are requested to go through the following instructions carefully for their own convenience and to ensure smooth and successful conduct of the above Championship.

1) MATCHES:-

All the matches will be conducted according to NRAI Match Book. The Match Book is available on our website www.thenrai.in

A shooter is eligible to participate in AIGVMSC only if he/she has achieved the following minimum qualifying scores as per Rule 1.4 of NRAI Match Book in the previous AIGVMSC, Zonal Championship or State Championship (Full course as per NRAI Match Book), conducted by the State Rifle Association in those events in which he/she wishes to participate. Please refer to rule 1.6 of NRAI Match Book as Annexure “B” as attached. Scores of such competitions must be filled at the time of filing online entry for AIGVMSC. **Shooters furnishing wrong information shall be debarred from taking part in any Championship for two years.**

Shooters who failed to maintain the Minimum Qualifying Scores as per Rule 17.6 of NRAI Match Book during previous NSCC will enter in Matches for MQS only and will not be eligible for any Medal/Ranking. Please see Rule 10.6 of NRAI Match Book.

2 ENTRY FORMS/ FEE

- a. The entries will be accepted through respective NRAI’s affiliated State Rifle Association/Units only. **THE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED ONLY “ON NRAI’s ONLINE SYTEM” and no paper entry will be accepted. The shooters are required to visit our website www.thenrai.org to file their entries along with online payment of entry fee. The online entries with normal fee will be accepted till 7.30 PM on 22nd August, 2023. Late entries with triple entry fee will be accepted till 07.30 PM on 24th August, 2023.**
- b. In case any shooter/affiliated unit need any assistance for filing the entry, he/she must approach NRAI immediately BUT before 07.30 PM on 22nd August, 2023 so that their entries are accepted with normal fee. Shooters contacting for assistance after 22nd August, 2023 are liable to pay triple fee. Shooters may contact Mr. Anjan Singh in NRAI office on number 9555046539 during working hours. - c. Shooters, who have not received/applied for their Shooter ID number, must immediately visit our website www.thenrai.org to check status/apply for their Shooter ID number.

3. **PARTICIPATION**

- a. Shooters, who are completing the age, as stated below in 2023, will be allowed to participate under age categories matches:

Juniors – 21 years	Born in 2002 or above.
Masters – between 45 – 60 years	Born in 1963 – 1978.
Senior Masters – 61 – 70 years	Born in 1953 – 1962.
Super Masters – 71 years	Born in 1952 or below

- a. No Certificates will be issued to shooters failing to achieve the qualifying scores as per rule 1.4 above during All India G V Mavlankar Shooting Championship.
- b. The State Rifle Associations/Units will be imposed a penalty of Rs. 3000/- (plus 18% GST = Rs.3540/-) per shooter in case their shooters score below 15% of the qualifying score as per NRAI Match Book rule 1.4 during All India G V Mavlankar Shooting Championship. The State/Unit must deposit the penalty amount with NRAI immediately otherwise shooters from that unit/state will not be allowed to participate in any competition conducted by NRAI. The Secretary General may also call for explanation of the unit/state for sending such shooters. Shooters participating in AIGVMSC on the basis of their performance during any competition conducted by NRAI shall be exempted.
- c. A penalty of Rs. 200/- (plus 18% GST = Rs.236/-) will be charged if a shooter loses his/her competitor card and equipment sheet during the competition and fresh card and equipment sheet will only be issued on deposit of penalty.
- d. Shooters, who achieve MQS as prescribed under Clause 17.6 (NR) of NRAI Match Book during this Championship, will be permitted to participate in 66th NSCC in those events in which MQS has been achieved. Please refer to Annexure “A2” attached.
- e. Entry of Renowned shooters will not be accepted in MQS category for the purpose of training or otherwise.
- f. **SHOOTERS BELOW THE AGE OF 12 YEARS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN FIREARM EVENTS DURING THIS CHAMPIONSHIP.**

4. **AWARD OF MEDALS**

The medals will be awarded in individual category as follows:

4 shooters 3 Medals
3 Shooters 2 Medals
2 shooters 1 Medal
1 shooter no Medal
Master/Sr. Master and Super Master exempted.

5. **IMPORTANT**

Only three (3) shooters will be allowed to use common weapon. The names of shooters likely to use common weapon should be intimated together with the weapon number to the Organizing Secretary in advance to enable to work out the details for the conduct of the relevant matches.

6. **ACCOMMODATION**

There are vast range of hotels available in Mhow & Indore. Shooters are requested to contact hotels directly for their bookings.

7. AMMUNITION

Ammunition may be provided subject to availability with NRAI at Shooting Range against payment and on valid arms license

8. COVID PROTOCOLS

Due to COVID – 19 conditions, shooters are requested to strictly follow SOPs as laid down by Govt. of India/MP Govt.

9. GENERAL

- a. All participants are requested to go through the above instructions carefully and ensure strict compliance.
- b. All participants are expected to abide by the rules and regulations for the competition. Discipline on and off the field is very essential.
- c. In case of non-participation by the competitors after submission of their entries will not be allowed any refund of the Entry Fee.
- d. Shooting practice in hotels is strictly prohibited.
- e. The Organizers will have the right to close any match or event in case of any emergency or otherwise without assigning any reason for such an action on their part.

FOR PARA SHOOTERS

Shooter who achieves MQS as per Annexure will be eligible to participate in 66th NSCC. Shooters who achieve MQS as per Annexure “ will be notified as “Renowned Shooter “and they will also be eligible for grant of Import permit for Import of their equipment’s.

All Shooters, who are already registered, are also required to upload their medical categorization certificate as approved by PCI, if not done earlier. Without a medical categorization certificate, no entry will be accepted under Para Category.
