Sub: XXIV All India Kumar Surendra Singh Inter School Shooting Championship 2022 in Air Weapon events at Asansol Rifle Club, Chandmari, Paschim Bardhaman, Asansol, West Bengal from 18th to 24th September, 2022.

Dear Sir,

This is to inform you that the XXIV All India Kumar Surendra Singh Inter School Shooting Championship 2022 in Air Weapon events will be held at **Asansol Rifle Club, Chandmari, Paschim Bardhaman, Asansol, West Bengal from 18th to 24th September, 2022.** It will be conducted by the Asansol Rifle Club under the patronage of NRAI, as per the program attached. Shooters from all over the country are invited to participate in this Championship. The terms and conditions are as under: -

1. The competition is open to school students all over the country in individual and team events.
2. Students will represent their respective State Rifle Associations.
3. All the affiliated units are advised to conduct their state level inter School Shooting Competitions using “Online Software of NRAI to enable the shooters to file their entries for this Championship. The shooters who achieve the following MQS, during State Inter School Shooting Championship or any competition recognized by NRAI, are eligible to participate in this Championship: -

4. Shooters, who have not received/ applied for their Shooter ID number, must immediately visit our website www.thenrai.org to check status/apply for their Shooter ID number.

5. The entries will be accepted through respective affiliated State Rifle Association/Units only. THE ENTRIES WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED “NRAI’s ONLINE SYSTEM” and no paper entry will be accepted. The Shooters are required to visit our website www.thenrai.org to file their entries along with online payment of entry fee. The online entries with normal fee will be accepted till 5 PM on 9th September, 2022. Late entries with triple entry fee will be accepted till 5 PM 12th September, 2022.

6. In case any Shooter/Affiliated unit needs any assistance for filing the entry, he/she must approach NRAI immediately BUT before 5PM on 9th September, 2022 so that their entries are accepted with normal fee. Shooters contacting for assistance after 9th September, 2022 are liable to pay triple fee. Shooters may contact Mr. Anjan Singh in NRAI office on phone number 9555046539 during working hours. Shooters may also send email on email ID indiashooting@gmail.com .

7. Entry fee will not be refunded except in the event of the match being cancelled. The entry fee should be paid “online” and no cash/draft will be accepted. Shooters will be permitted to shoot only in the details and lanes allotted to them. No requests regarding change of firing points/relays/dates will be entertained. Protest fee is Rs. 300/-

8. Team events will be conducted in National Rule (NR) Matches only. Teams can be formed by the shooters of same State and only one team consisting of three shooters per State will be allowed in each event. Final entry of three members of the team must be submitted latest by 5 PM on 18th September, 2022 at Asansol Rifle Club_Chandmari, Paschim Bardhaman, Asansol, West Bengal.

9. Participation in various age category matches will be as per Rule 11 of NRAI Match Book. The age of the shooter (junior below the age of 19 years, youth below the age of 18 years and Sub Youth below the age of 15 years) will be calculated from the first day of the competition, (18th September, 2022).

10. Those shooters who are taking part in ISSF matches and are members of the Core Group are not allowed to take part in National Rule Matches.

11. Shooters who have taken part in international competitions are not allowed to take part in this Competition.

12. Shooters can take part in one category i.e. Junior, Youth or Sub Youth. Individual and team medals will be awarded as under: -

1. 3 medals where there is a minimum of 4 entries
2. 2 medals where there is a minimum of 3 entries
3. 1 medal where there is a minimum of 2 entries
4. No medal in case there is a single entry

13. The competition will be conducted according to ISSF Rules and NRAI Match Book 2022 (amended).

14. No arms will be provided to the competitors by NRAI. Air pellets will be made available against cash payment at the range.

15. All the students must be in their School uniform at the time of March Past in Opening/Closing and Prize Distribution Ceremony. Schools are requested to send their school Flags for March Past during Opening/Closing Ceremony.

16. The details/lanes would be allotted in the name of State Rifle Associations and not to individual shooters. All the participating States/Unit should officially nominate a Team Manager for the championship and he should ensure that details/lanes allotted to state/unit are allocated to the shooters without any inconvenience. The Team Manager or his/her authorized representative only will attend the Managers meetings, submit protests, if any, and be sole in-charge of day-to-day affairs of the team concerned. Scoring protest can be lodged by the concerned shooters also.

17. Matches in Open Sight Air Rifle have been deleted from the program of this Championship.

COVID PROTOCOLS

- i. Due to COVID – 19 conditions, shooters are requested to strictly follow SOPs as laid down by Govt. of India/NRAI/West Bengal Govt.
- ii. All shooters/coaches must undergo a Covid test prior to entering the range on the first day for Training and submit a negative report from a Govt. certified lab to the Organizers. This report should not be older than 48 hours from the date of first entry into the range for PET. VIOLATION OF COVID PROTOCOLS MAY LEAD FROM DISQUALIFICATION FROM THIS COMPETITION.
- iii. The tentative program is attached herewith. The time and date would be notified on the website of NRAI www.thenrai.org Shooters are required to enter the range 90 minutes before the reporting time at range so that they can report on time for their detail.
- iv. Only one person will be allowed to accompany the shooter subject to production of valid negative COVID – 19 reports.
