GENERAL REGULATIONS

1. ORGANIZERS

The 0175 INDIA OPEN COMPETITION (SHOTGUN) 2025 is being organized and conducted by the National Rifle Association of India at New Moti Bagh Gun Club, Patiala, Punjab

2. NAME OF THE COMPETITION

0175 INDIA OPEN COMPETITION (SHOTGUN) EVENTS 2025.

3. VENUE

NEW MOTI BAGH GUN CLUB, PATIALA, PUNJAB.

4. COMPETITION DATES

FROM 29th October to 5th November, 2025.

5. LEVEL OF COMPETITION

The Level of the Competition is Pre-National Level Competition as defined under Rule 1.1.2.1 of NRAI Match Book.

6. CONDUCT OF COMPETITION

a) The Matches will be conducted in accordance with NRAI Match Book under NR Rules and ISSF Rules.

7. ELIGIBITY CRITERIA Eligibility for Participate in India Open Competition

- I) Athletes who have participated in Pre-State Championship/State Championship/AIGVMSC/Zonal Championship/India Open Competition or in NSCC are eligible to participate in normal matches of this Competition. In case any State Rifle Association fails to conduct the Pre-State Championship, the NRAI reserves the right to allow athletes of that State to participate in India Open Competition.
- II) Athletes who are notified as "Renowned Shot" during $66^{th}/67^{th}$ NSCC are eligible to participate in ISSF Matches. Athletes achieving MQS during one of the India Open Competitions, as per Rule 17.6 of NRAI, will be eligible to participate in NSCC
- III) Athletes may participate in multiple India Open Competitions prior to NSCC. One of the highest scores during India Open Competition, which is equal or above to NR MQS under Rule 17.6 of NRAI Match Book, will be considered for participation in NSCC. (Clarification if a athlete fails to achieve MQS in subsequent Competitions, he/she still will be allowed to participate in NSCC based on said high score.)

A penalty of Rs. 3000/- (plus 18% GST = Rs.3540/- as applicable) per athlete per event will be imposed on athlete in case athlete's score is below 15% of the qualifying score as per NRAI Match Book rule 1.4 during the Competition. The State/Unit must recover this amount from the athletes. The State Rifle Association will be responsible for recovery of penalty and deposit the same with NRAI. athletes will not be permitted to participate in any competition till the penalty amount is paid to NRAI.

8. REPRESENTATION AND ENTRY

The representation and entry for participation in 0175 INDIA OPEN COMPETITION is as per Rule 6 of NRAI Match Book. The athlete would represent the State as per their registration on NRAI's "Online system". Entries will be accepted on NRAI portal www.thenrai.org The last dates for accepting entries are as under:

With normal fee – 25th October, till 7.30 pm With triple fee – 26th October, till 7.30 pm

9. AGE CRITERIA & CATEGORIES

Athletees, who are completing the age, as stated below in 2025, will be allowed to participate under age categories matches:

Seniors

Juniors – 21 years

Youth - 19 years or before

Above the age of 21 years

Born in 2004 or after

Born in 2006 or after

Masters – 45 -- 60 years
Senior Masters – 60 – 70 years
Super Masters – 70 years
Should have completed 45 years one day before Competition
Should have completed 70 years one day before Competition

Youth, Juniors may participate in Senior Category. Similarly, the Super Masters may participate in all age category matches except junior and Youth category. Senior Masters may participate in Masters and Seniors category. Masters can participate in Senior category. Participation in various categories is with the payment of additional entry fee as Per rule.

ATHLETES BELOW THE AGE OF 12 YEARS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE DURING THIS CHAMPIONSHIP.

11. AWARD OF MEDALS

- a) Gold, Silver and Bronze Medal will be awarded in each category in individual events.
- b) Individual medals will be awarded on the basis of Qualification Scores in all categories.
- c). Rule 10 of NRAI Match Book will apply for award of medals.

12. ENTRY FEE

Single Entry fee - Rs.2000/- per match plus 18% GST = Rs.2360/-Triple Entry fee -- Rs.2000/- X 3 = Rs.6000/- + 18% GST = Rs.7080/-

16. PROTESTS AND APPEALS

The Protests and appeals will be dealt as per ISSF & NRAI Match Book. The Protest fee is Rs. 200/-(plus 18%) Rs.236/- and in case of appeal to Jury of Appeal, the protest fee is Rs. 500/-(plus 18% GST) Rs.590/-.

17. ACCOMMODATION

Participants are requested to kindly make their own arrangements for accommodation. A wide range of hotels for all budgets are available in Patiala, Punjab.

18. GENERAL

All participants are requested to go through the above instructions carefully and ensure strict compliance:

- a. All participants are expected to abide by the rules and regulations for the competition. Discipline on and off the field is very essential.
- b. A sum of Rs. 236/- (Rs.200/- plus 18% GST) will be charged if a athlete loses his/her competitor card during the competition and duplicate card will only be issued on deposit of amount.
- c. In case of non-participation by the competitors after submission of their entries, entry fee will not be refunded.
- d. Shooting kit (clothing & Equipment) of the competitors during the competition will be strictly according to ISSF Rules.
- e. Shooting practice in hotels is strictly prohibited.
- f. The Organizers will have the right to close any match or event in case of any emergency or otherwise without assigning any reason for such an action on their part.
- g. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to amend the rules at any time at its sole discretion for events/circumstances beyond its control. Any decision made by the Organizing Committee in any such matter will be final.
- h. All participants are expected to abide by the rules and regulations for the competitions. Discipline on and off the field is very essential.

CODE OF CONDUCT

- 1. Be a responsible human being and a committed sports person.
- 2. Be respectful towards fellow athletes, officials, Coaches, support staff and staff of working at ranges
- 3. Be punctual and diligent and adhere schedule timings.
- 4. Follow directions by officials.
- 5. Shall be dressed appropriately in a dress code prescribed by ISSF.
- **6.** Be disciplined on and off the field.
- 7. Must not verbally abuse or intimidate in any form such as shouting making gesture, towards or in any other way distract any spectator, tournament official, technical official, opposing coach or opposing team official, or opposing player
- **8.** Shall not indulge in any political or religious and other discourse/discussions.
- 9. Should not make any inappropriate or unwanted physical, verbal, or sexual advance towards anyone.
- 10. Adhere to rules as set by Govt. of India/Sports Authority of India/NRAI or any agency related to the Championship.
- 11. Shall abide by the Code of Ethics of ISSF.
- 12. Should not consume alcohol or tobacco at range.
- 13. It's the responsibility of the athlete to be aware of all the rules and be responsible for their equipment being as per ISSF regulations.
- **14.** Athlete is responsible for following all rules/norms and go through the notices issued by NRAI at Range/Website of NRAI.

- 15. Adhere WADA/NADA rules and not to use drugs, which are not permitted under WADA/NADA rules.
- 16. In case of any grievance, please contact the Director of Competition, as per details given below.
- 17. Shall not interact with media in any form or over any print/electronic/social platform or post any material, which is contrary to the spirit of IOC Charter, ISSF Rules, shooting sport, fellow athletes, coaches, other office bearers of NRAI and against the policies of Govt. of India/SAI/NRAI.
- 18. Must not bring the shooting sport into disrepute through media that relate to tournament officials, technical officials, opposing coaches or team officials and or players, that are personal in nature, imply bias, or question their integrity.
- 19. Violation of above may lead to cancellation of entry of this Championship.
