PARTICIPATION CRITERIA

Proposed criteria for participation in National Games:

- a. 15 Shooters in each event as per National Ranking prepared after considering the averages of Senior Group A, (after Asian Games), Group A of juniors and Group B, (after Trial 5 and 6). (List attached)
- b. 01 Shooter per event for Host State (GOA), if there is no shooter in the ranking list above. In case shooter from Goa is already in ranking list, then the 16th rank shooter will be included.
- c. On the “principal of Universality”, One shooter, per event, will be allowed to participate in each event from a State which does not have any shooter in the list of first 15 national ranked shooters. This will provide opportunity to shooters of those states, which does have any shooter in first 15 national rankings. This quota is not transferable to other event by the State Rifle Association and maximum participation under this quota would be ONE only per event. The norm for fielding the shooters under this Quota is as under:
 - i. In fire arm events – any shooter, who is eligible to participate in 66 NSCC, can be fielded.
 - ii. In Air weapon events – any shooter who has participated at a State Level and eligible to shoot zonal/AIGVSMC can be fielded.
- d. The shooters from para military/Railways/ONGC etc, if they are in first 15 ranks, will represent their state of domicile or State of posting - which should be more than six months old. In this case their participation will not be counted under the State quota as per (c) above. The shooters from Army, Navy and Air Force will represent Services Sports Control Board (SSCB).
- e. Coach and Team officials: One Manager and One coach for States fielding up to shooters. One Manager and two coaches, the shooters are more than five.
- f. Shooters for Mix events will be fielded by the Affiliated units from the shooters participating in individual events. So separate Quota is awarded.
