All Shooters eligible to Participate in Khelo India Selection Trial

SUB: Selection Trial 1 & 2 for Rifle/Pistol events at Dr. Karni Singh Shooting Ranges, New Delhi from 17th to 22nd October 2021 for selection of shooters in Khelo India 2021.

Dear Sir/Madam,

The Organizing Committee (OC) of Khelo India 2021 has now decided to conduct the 3rd Khelo India 2021 from 5th to 14th February 2022 at Dr Karni Singh Shooting Ranges, New Delhi. The detailed schedule of Khelo India Games will be notified in due course of time.

The Selection Trials, to select shooters for Khelo India Youth Games, will be held at Dr Karni Singh Shooting Ranges, New Delhi from 17th to 22nd October 2021.

The OC of Khelo India 2021 has fixed criteria for participation in Khelo India 2021. The shooters, born on 1.1.2003 or afterward are only eligible to participate in Khelo India in Air Rifle and Air Pistol Men and Women events, as per letter received from the OC.

It has been decided that:

1. Two selection trials from 17th to 22nd October 2021 will be conducted at Dr. Karni Singh Shooting Ranges, New Delhi for the shooters who are born as on 1.1.2003 or afterwards.
2. The shooters, as per para 1 above, who participated in 63 NSCC and have achieved MQS under Rule 17.6 of NRAI Match Book, are eligible to participate in selection trials
3. A list of shooters in each event is attached herewith as per para 1 above. Shooters, as per list attached, are only allowed to participate in two selection trials.
4. All shooters as per list attached MUST file their details on the link <https://nsrs.kheloindia.gov.in/Home/NSRS> immediately to avoid any delay in filing their entry.
5. Only 16 shooters in each event will be selected to participate in Khelo India. The ranking will be calculated as under:
 - a. Base Score – achieved during 63 NSCC qualification score only
 - b. Selection Trial 1 score
 - c. Selection Trial 2 score

Average of two high scores under (a)to(c) will be the basis of final ranking and first 16 shooters in each event will be selected to participate in Khelo India 2021. Ties will be broken in accordance with ISSF Rules.
6. No Finals will be conducted and average of qualification score will be the basis of final ranking.
7. The shooters will have to make their own arrangements for their boarding/lodging and transport for their participation in Selection Trials.

The revised schedule of Selection Trials is attached herewith. Due to prevailing COVID conditions, this is a tentative schedule and can be changed/cancelled. The NRAI will, in no way, be responsible for any loss due to change in schedule.

9. The other terms and conditions for selection trials are as under:
- i. Shooters are requested to strictly follow the COVID – 19 SOPs as laid down by Govt. of India/NRAI/Delhi Govt.
 - ii. All shooters/coaches must undergo a Covid test and submit a negative report from a Govt. certified lab to NRAI prior to entering the range for first trial. This report should not be older than 48 hours from the date of first trial.
 - iii. The tentative program is attached herewith. There will be only one detail for each event. No request for any adjustment shall be entertained. The time and details are attached herewith and shooters are required to enter the range 90 minutes before the reporting time at range so that they can report on time for their detail.
 - iv. Only one person will be allowed to accompany the shooter subject to production of valid negative COVID – 19 report by the accompanying person. This report should not be older than 48 hours from the date of first trial.
 - v. Shooters will have to make their own arrangements for arms and boarding & lodging. Air pellets will be provided at Shooting Ranges against payment.
 - vi. The entries will only be accepted through “NRAI’s ONLINE SYTEM”. No paper entry will be accepted. Shooters are required to visit our website www.thenrai.org to file their online entries. The online entries with normal fee will be accepted **till 9.30 PM on 8th October 2021. Late entries with triple entry fee will be accepted till 9.30 PM on 12th October 2021.**
 - vii. Entry Fee for both the trials is Rs. 2500/-.
 - viii. In case any shooter/affiliated unit need any assistance for filing the entry, he/she must approach NRAI immediately BUT during working hours **before 5.30 PM on 8th October 2021** so that their entries are accepted with normal fee. Shooters contacting for assistance after 8th October 2021 are liable to pay triple fee. Shooters may contact Mr. Anjan Singh in NRAI office on phone numbers 011-8448770867. - IX. ENTRIES OF THOSE SHOOTERS, WHO FILED THEIR ENTRIES FOR THE SELECTION TRIALS IN JULY 2021 AND HAVE NOT TAKEN REFUND OF ENTRY FEE, WILL REMAIN VALID. ALL OTHER SHOOTERS WHO HAVE BEEN REFUNDED ENTRY FEE OR DID NOT FILE THEIR ENTRIES EARLIER, ARE REQUIRED TO FILE FRESH ENTRIES ON OUR SYSTEM.**
- x. Shooters are required to print their competitor cards and Equipment Control Form and bring the same with them at the time of participation, failing which Rs. 200/- will be collected for each card/form, if supplied by NRAI. Shooters can print their cards/forms after 15th October 2021
