

011 INDIA OPEN COMPETITION – RIFLE/PISTOL 2023 FROM 01 TO 07 MARCH, 2023

GENERAL REGULATIONS

The objective of organizing the INDIA OPEN COMPETITIONS is to provide more shooting opportunities at different venues all over India.

1. ORGANIZERS

The 011 INDIA OPEN COMPETITION RIFLE/PISTOL, 2023 is being conducted by the National Rifle Association of India at Dr. Karni Singh Shooting Ranges, New Delhi.

2. NAME OF THE COMPETITION

011 INDIA OPEN COMPETITION (RIFLE/PISTOL) 2023

3. VENUE

DR. KARNI SINGH SHOOTING RANGES, NEW DELHI

4. COMPETITION DATES

MARCH 01 - 07, 2023

5. LEVEL OF COMPETITION

The level of the Championship is "Grand Prix". The scores of this competition will not be considered for National Ranking or for the purpose of "Aspiring Shooter" certification.

6. CONDUCT OF COMPETITION

Participation will be as per Rules & Regulations of ISSF and NRAI Match Book.

7. ELIGIBITY CRITERIA

- a. The competition is open to the shooters, who have participated in NSCC in one of the last three NSCC.
- b. Shooters participated in a state level competition are eligible to participate in NR Matches, subject to the condition that the scores of such competitions are not older than two years. The scores of such State Championships must be available on the "online system" of NRAI.



8. REPRESENTATION AND ENTRY

The representation and entry for participation in 011 INDIA OPEN COMPETITION (RIFLE/PISOL) New Delhi 2023 is as per Rule 6 of NRAI Match Book. The shooter would represent the State as per their registration on NRAI's "Online system". Entries will be accepted on NRAI portal www.thenrai.org The last dates for accepting entries are as under:

With normal fee – 24th February 2023 With triple fee – 26th February, 2023

9. AGE CRITERIA & CATEGORIES

The age criteria will be as per NRAI Match Book/ISSF Rules.

The matches will be conducted in the following age categories for Men and Women:

Seniors – above the age of 21 years as on date of opening day of the Competition

Juniors – below the age of 21 years Senior Masters – above 60 years

Masters – between the age of 45 years and below 60 years

Senior Masters may participate in master's and Senior age Category matches.

Juniors may participate in Senior Category.

Deaf shooters – There will be only one age category – Men and Women. However, Deaf shooters may participate in other category matches according to their age but there no separate medal will be awarded under those categories to Deaf shooters.

Juniors may participate in Senior Category. The Youth may participate in senior and junior category matches. The Sub Youth Category shooters are allowed to participate in all categories except Masters and Senior Masters matches

10. LIST OF EVENTS

All categories for Men and Women (as per Annexure A)

10M Rifle 60 shots 10M Pistol 60 shots



11. FORMAT FOR THE MATCHES

The Matches will be conducted in 60 shots as per rules of ISSF with decimal scoring for 10M Air Rifle events and full ring values for 10m Air Pistol events. No Finals will be conducted. Medals will be awarded based on Qualification scores. The ties will be broken as per ISSF rules.

Any NR shooter, who achieves MQS as per rule 17.6 of NRAI Match Book, in two or more Competitions, will be allowed to participate directly in the upcoming NSCC. For the purpose of NR MQS under Rule 17.6 of NRAI for NSCC, the scores of first two rounds (50 birds) will be considered.

13. AWARD OF MEDALS

Based on the Qualification Scores, the Gold, Silver and Bronze Medal will be awarded in each category, as stated under Rules 9 and 11 above and as per NRAI Match Book

14. CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS TROPHY

.

There will be Finals for Champion of Champions in the senior category of 10M Air Rifle and 10M Air Pistol. Shooters based on Final rankings of Qualification Scores in Senior men and women will participate for Champion of Champions Trophy match.

The top 18 athletes, in each event, will shoot 15 shots, in a "Knock out Round" (KOR) round. All athletes will start with score zero in the KOR.

Decimal Scoring will be in all KOR, Semi Final and Medal Matches.

Ties: In case of tie in KOR and Semi Final stage, for the lowest ranking place, the tied athletes will fire additional single shot(s) in fifty seconds until the tie is broken

The KOR will consist of 03 series of five shots each. The time for each series will be 250 seconds.

At the end of the 2_{nd} series, six athletes with the lowest score will be eliminated. Ties, if any, will be broken with "shoot off".

At the end of the 3rd series, four athletes with the lowest score (based on total of all the three series) will be eliminated. Ties, if any, will be broken with "shoot off".



The remaining eight athletes will qualify for the Semi Finals (as per ISSF rules – Final Ranking format). All athletes will start with score zero.

The top two athletes from semi-final will play the TROPHY match (as per ISSF rules – Final Medal Match format).

The winner in each category will be awarded Champion of Champions Trophy.

The Champion of Champions match will be conducted with "fanfare". Traditional folk music will be played during the conduct of the Champion of Champions Matches. Spectators will be allowed to support their shooters by using drums etc.

15. TEAM REPRESENTATION

- a. The participation in team events will be in accordance with Rule 18 of NRAI Match Book. Team events will only be conducted in Senior and Junior events for Men and Women. Shooters of the same State can participate in Team events. Each State can field a maximum of two teams. The team rankings will on the basis of score out of 75 birds. In case of Tie, the same would be broken according to ISSF Rules.
- b. The team entries will be accepted from the authorized person nominated by the State Rifle Association/Unit.
- c. Final entry of three members of the team must be submitted latest by 17.00 hrs.

16. ENTRY FEE

Individual Entry Fee – Rs. 2000/- per match plus 18% GST(Rifle/Pistol) Team Entry Fee – Rs. 1500/- per team plus 18% GST

17. AMMUNITON

The ammunition will available at NRAI camp office at Dr. Karni Singh Shooting Ranges.

19. PROTESTS AND APPEALS

The Protests and appeals will be dealt as per ISSF & NRAI Match Book 2022 (Amended). The Protest fee is Rs. 200/-(plus 18%) Rs.236/- and in case of appeal to Jury of Appeal, the protest fee is Rs. 500/-(plus 18% GST) Rs.590/-

20. ACCOMMODATION

Participants are requested to kindly make their own arrangements for accommodation. A wide range of hotels for all budgets are available in New Delhi.

21. GENERAL

All participants are requested to go through the above instructions carefully and ensure strict compliance:

- a. All participants are expected to abide by the rules and regulations for the competition. Discipline on and off the field is very essential.
- b. Penalty of Rs. 236/- (Rs.200/- plus 18% GST) will be charged if a shooter loses his/her competitor card during the competition and fresh card will only be issued on deposit of penalty.
- c. In case of non-participation by the competitors after submission of their entries will not be allowed any refund of the Entry Fee.
- d. Shooting kit (clothing & Equipment) of the competitors during the competition will be strictly according to ISSF Rules.
- e. Shooting practice in hotels is strictly prohibited.
- f. The Organizers will have the right to close any match or event in case of any emergency or otherwise without assigning any reason for such an action on their part.
- g. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to amend the rules at any time at its sole discretion for events/circumstances beyond its control. Any decision made by the Organizing Committee in any such matter will be final.
- h. All participants are expected to abide by the rules and regulations for the competitions. Discipline on and off the field is very essential.



22. COVID PROTOCOLS

- a. Due to COVID 19 conditions, shooters are requested to strictly follow SOPs as laid down by Govt. of India/Delhi Govt.
- b. All shooters/coaches must undergo a COVID-19 test prior to entering the range for training and submit a negative report from a Govt. certified lab to NRAI. This report should not be older than 48 hours from the date of your first entry at the range.
- c. No request for any adjustment shall be entertained. The details of squads will be notified on the website of NRAI. Shooters are required to enter the range 90 minutes before the reporting time at range so that they can report on time for their detail.
- d. Only one person will be allowed to accompany the shooter subject to production of valid negative COVID–19 reports.
