

NEW FORMAT FOR THE CONDUCT OF TRAP AND SKEET EVENTS DURING NSCC

The following format has been recommended by the Technical Committee of NRAI for the conduct of Trap and Skeet events during NSCC.

RATIONALE FOR NEW FORMAT

There is an immense increase of entries in the Trap and Skeet events over the years. This leads to the competition being conducted over many days, which can be detrimental to the athletes' performance.

NEW FORMAT FOR TRAP DURING NSCC:

The athletes have been divided into 3 groups to enable us to conduct the competition as per ISSF recommended schedule

GROUP 1

QUALIFIERS FROM AIGVMSC/ZONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS – IN ALL MEN/WOMEN/MEN JUNIOR/ WOMEN JUNIOR CATEGORIES, SENIOR MASTERS (MEN & WOMEN).

ALL ATHLETES, WHO SHOT UPTO AND INCLUDING A SCORE OF 74 IN PREVIOUS NSCC (INCLUDING ISSF TRAP WOMEN AND JUNIOR WOMEN)

GROUP 2

ALL ATHLETES WHO SHOT A SCORE OF 75 AND UPTO AND INCLUDING 100 IN PREVIOUS NSCC – OPEN MEN/WOMEN/MEN JUNIOR/ WOMEN JUNIOR/ MASTERS – MEN/WOMEN

GROUP 3

ALL ATHLETES WHO SHOT A SCORE OF 101 AND ABOVE IN PREVIOUS NSCC - MEN/WOMEN/MEN JUNIOR/ WOMEN JUNIOR

NEW FORMAT FOR SKEET DURING NSCC:

The athletes have been divided into 2 groups to enable us to conduct the competition as per ISSF recommended schedule

GROUP 1

QUALIFIERS FROM AIGVMSC/ZONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS – MEN/WOMEN/MEN JUNIOR/WOMEN JUNIOR AND SENIOR MASTERS.

ALL ATHLETES WHO SHOT UPTO AND INCLUDING A SCORE OF 74 IN PREVIOUS NSCC (INCLUDING ISSF SKEET WOMEN AND JUNIOR WOMEN)

GROUP 2

ALL ATHLETES WHO SHOT A SCORE OF 75 AND ABOVE IN PREVIOUS NSCC - MEN/WOMEN/MEN JUNIOR/ WOMEN JUNIOR, MASTERS

MEN, WOMEN, JR MEN, JR WOMEN & MASTERS

NOTE:

- ALL ATHLETES WILL MANDATORILY SHOOT ON DAYS ALLOCATED FOR THEIR GROUP (GROUP 1, 2 OR 3) ONLY.
- ALL ATHLETES, IRRESPECTIVE OF DIFFERENT CATEGORIES, THEY HAVE ENTERED, WILL SHOOT ONLY ONCE DURING THE COURSE OF THE NSCC.

EXAMPLE: ATHLETES REQUIRED TO PLAY IN GROUP 1, WILL ONLY PLAY ON DAYS SCHEDULED FOR GROUP 1. THEY CAN NOT PLAY IN ANY OTHER GROUP/S. THIS WILL APPLY TO ATHLETES OF ALL GROUPS.

- SENIOR MASTERS ENTERED IN SENIOR MASTERS AND MEN/WOMEN CATEGORY, WILL MANDATORILY SHOOT ONLY ON THE DAYS ALLOTTED FOR THE SENIOR MASTERS EVENT (GROUP 1) AND THEIR SCORES, HOWEVER, WILL BE COUNTED TOWARDS BOTH THE CATEGORIES.
- MASTERS ENTERED IN MASTERS AND OPEN MEN/WOMEN CATEGORY WILL MANDATORILY SHOOT ONLY ON THE DAYS ALLOTTED FOR THE MASTERS EVENT (GROUP 2) AND THEIR SCORES, HOWEVER, WILL BE COUNTED TOWARDS BOTH THE CATEGORIES.

- ALL ATHLETES IN JUNIOR AND SENIOR CATEGORIES WILL MANDATORILY SHOOT ONLY ON THE DAYS ALLOTTED FOR THEIR GROUP AND THEIR SCORES WILL, HOWEVER, BE COUNTED TOWARDS BOTH THE CATEGORIES. (FOR EXAMPLE, ATHLETES WHO QUALIFY FROM AIGVMSC/ZONAL CHAMPIONSHIP WILL SHOOT UNDER GROUP 1 MATCHES, WILL BE ELIGIBLE TO SHOOT THE FINALS, IF THEY RANK WITHIN FIRST 8 POSITIONS UNDER THEIR CATEGORIES)
- AT THE END OF COMPETITION, (AFTER GROUP 2 (SKEET) AND GROUP 3 (TRAP), A CONSOLIDATED RANKING LIST WILL BE PREPARED AND FINALISTS FOR EACH CATEGORY WILL BE SELECTED TO SHOOT THE FINALS.
- THE TOP 08 ATHLETES WILL PLAY THE SEMI FINALS OF THEIR RESPECTIVE CATEGORY, AS SCHEDULED (IRRESPECTIVE OF WHICH GROUP THEY PLAYED IN)
- FOR TEAM EVENTS THE OLD FORMAT WILL CONTINUE TO BE APPLICABLE. MEDALS AND RANKINGS WILL BE DECIDED AS PER QUALIFICATION SCORE ONLY. THERE WILL NOT BE ANY SEPARATE MATCH/FINAL FOR THE TEAM EVENT
- FOR PURPOSES OF BEING DECLARED A RENOWNED SHOT, AN ATHLETE MUST ACHIEVE MQS AS PER RULE 17.6 OF NRAI MATCH BOOK. ATHLETES WHO FAIL TO ACHIEVE MQS AS PER THE STATED RULE 17.6 OF NRAI MATCH BOOK WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO IMPORT ANY ARMS/AMMUNITION
