SUB: 3rd DIGVIJAY SINGH MEMORIAL SHOOTING CHAMPIONSHIP IN SHOTGUN EVENTS
AT MP SHOOTING ACADEMY, BHOPAL FROM 21ST TO 30TH JANUARY, 2025.

Dear Sir/Madam,

The 3rd Digvijay Singh Memorial Shooting Championship in Shotgun Events will be held at MP Shooting Academy, Bhopal from 21st to 30th January, 2025 as per program attached at Annexure “A”. This will be organized by the National Rifle Association of India with the close cooperation of M P Shooting Academy, Department of Sports, MP Govt. The terms and conditions are as under:-

1. PARTICIPATION

Shooters who took part in 67th NSCC and have achieved MQS in ISSF matches as per rule 17.6 of NRAI Match Book are allowed to participate in this Championship. Copy of MQS is attached herewith for your ready reference at Annexure “B”

2. AGE CRITERIA

Shooters, who are completing the age, as stated below in 2025, will be allowed to participate under age categories matches:

Seniors	Above 21 years
Juniors – 21 years	Born in 2004 or after.
Masters – 45 -- 60 years	Should have completed 45 years one day before Competition
Senior Masters – 60 – 70 years	Should have completed 60 years one day before Competition
Super Masters – 70 years	Should have completed 70 years one day before Competition

Super Masters, Senior Master and Masters may participate in other categories except junior category matches. Juniors may participate in Senior Category.

SHOOTERS BELOW THE AGE OF 12 YEARS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN THIS CHAMPIONSHIP.

3. ELIGIBILITY

Shooters, who achieve MQS as per Rule 17.6 of NRAI Match Book 2024, during 67th NSCC are eligible to participate in this Championship.

In case shooter is not qualified in a particular event and adds his/her entry that event on the portal of NRAI, a penalty of Rs. 5000/- (plus GST, as applicable) shall be imposed on the shooter and will not be allowed to participate in that event. The shooter will be allowed to participate in other events of the NSCC only after payment of penalty amount.

4. FILING OF ENTRY

- a. Shooters may file their entry as under:

With normal fee – 20th January, 2025 till 7.30 pm

- b. Shooters may contact the NRAI on indiashooting@gmail.com for any further Information that may be required by them and might have not been covered by the above instructions.
- c. Juniors can also participate in Senior Category with the payment of additional fee as per rules.
- d. Entry fee will not be refunded except in the event of the match being canceled. The entry fee should be paid “online” only and no cash/draft will be accepted.
- e. Shooters will be permitted to shoot only in the squads allotted to them. No requests regarding change of squads will be entertained.

5. TEAM REPRESENTATION

- A) Team events will be conducted in accordance with Rule 18 of NRAI Match Book. Only one Team from each State/ Unit will be allowed in each event irrespective of the number of participants. **Final entry of three members of the team must be submitted latest by 14.00 hrs. on the previous day of the start of that particular match.**
- B) The Mixed Team events will be conducted as per ISSF Rules. All affiliated units which wish to enter must file their entries **at NRAI Camp office at Bhopal** Only one team, consisting of one male and one female of the same state/unit, can be filed. Entry fee is Rs. 6000/-(plus 18% GST = Rs.7080/-) per team.

6. PROTESTS AND APPEALS

Protests and appeals will be dealt as per ISSF & NRAI Match Book. The Protest fee is Rs. 200/-(plus 18%) Rs.236/- and in case of appeal to Jury of Appeal, the protest fee is Rs. 500/-(plus 18% GST) Rs.590/-.

7. AMMUNITION

The ammunition will available at NRAI Camp office at Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh as per availability.

8. GENERAL

- a. In extra ordinary circumstances, the Organizing Secretary may grant permission for use of a common weapon. The names of shooters likely to use common weapon should be advised together with the weapon number to the Organizing Secretary in advance to enable him to work out details for conduct of relevant matches.
- b. All participants are requested to go through the above instructions carefully and ensure strict compliance.
- c. All participants are expected to abide by the rules and regulations for the competition. Discipline on and off the field is very essential.
- d. In case of non-participation by the competitors after submission of their entries will not be allowed any refund of the Entry Fee.
- e. Shooting kit (clothing & Equipment) of the competitors during the competition will be strictly according to ISSF Rules.
- f. Shooting practice in hotels is strictly prohibited.
- g. The Organizers will have the right to close any match or event in case of any emergency or otherwise without assigning any reason for such an action on their part.
- h. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to amend the rules at any time at its sole discretion for events/circumstances beyond its control. Any decision made by the Organizing Committee in any such matter will be final. All participants are expected to abide by the rules and regulations for the competitions. Discipline on and off the field is very essential. Shooting practice in hotels is strictly prohibited.
- i. Scores of this Championship will be considered for selection of International teams under the Selection Policy of NRAI.
- j. The scores as per score board/computerized score sheet, printed from the centralized scoring system installed at the range and shall only be valid. The Referees are required to make corrections, if any, on spot, during the round well before printing the score sheet. No correction is permissible once the printout has been taken.”

9. GENERAL

- a. All participants are requested to go through the above instructions carefully and ensure strict compliance.
- b. All participants are expected to abide by the rules and regulations for the competition. Discipline on and off the field is very essential.
- c. In case of non-participation by the competitors after submission of their entries will not be allowed any refund of the Entry Fee.
- d. Shooting kit (clothing & Equipment) of the competitors during the competition will be strictly according to ISSF Rules.
- e. Shooting practice in hotels is strictly prohibited. In case of any violation, disciplinary action shall be initiated and shooter may be debarred from taking part in that Competition.
- f. Accompanying person/personal coaches are not permitted to enter the Field of Play (FOP).
- g. The Organizers will have the right to close any match or event in case of any emergency or otherwise without assigning any reason for such an action on their part.
- h. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to amend the rules at any time at its sole discretion for events/circumstances beyond its control. Any decision made by the Organizing Committee in any such matter will be final. All participants are expected to abide by the rules and regulations for the competitions. Discipline on and off the field is very essential. Shooting practice in hotels is strictly prohibited.
- i. Scores of this Championship will be considered as for selection of National Squad and international competitions under the Selection Criteria 2025.

- j. The Selection of National Squad and international teams will be done in accordance with the Selection Criteria.
- k. Shooters achieving MQS during this Championship, as stated under Selection Criteria 2025, will be eligible to take part in Selection Trials 1 onwards.
- l. No request for any adjustment shall be entertained. The details of squads will be notified on the website of NRAI. Shooters are required to enter the range 90 minutes before the reporting time at range so that they can report on time for their detail.

10. COVID PROTOCOLS:

Due to COVID – 19 conditions, shooters are requested to strictly follow SOPs as laid down by Govt. of India/MP Govt.

11. CODE OF CONDUCT

- a. Be a responsible human being and a committed sports person.
- b. Be respectful towards fellow shooters, officials, Coaches, support staff and staff of NRAI.
- c. Be punctual and diligent and adhere schedule timings.
- d. Follow directions by officials.
- e. Shall be dressed appropriately in a dress code prescribed by ISSF.
- f. Be disciplined on and off the field.
- g. Must not verbally abuse or intimidate in any form such as shouting making gesture, towards or in any other way distract any spectator, tournament official, technical official, opposing coach or opposing team official, or opposing player
- h. Shall not indulge in any political or religious and other discourse/discussions/display.
- i. Should not make any inappropriate or unwanted physical, verbal, or sexual advance towards anyone.
- j. Adhere to rules as set by Govt. of India/Sports Authority of India/NRAI or any agency related to the Championship.
- k. Shall abide by the Code of Ethics of ISSF.
- l. Should not consume alcohol or tobacco at range.
- m. It's the responsibility of the shooter to be aware of all the rules and be responsible for their equipment being as per ISSF regulations.
- n. Shooter is responsible for following all rules/norms and go through the notices issued by NRAI at Range/Website of NRAI.
- o. Adhere WADA/NADA rules and not to use drugs, which are not permitted under WADA/NADA rules.
- p. In case of any grievance, please contact the Director of Competition, as per details given below.
- q. Shall not interact with media in any form or over any print/electronic/social platform or post any material, which is contrary to the spirit of IOC Charter, ISSF Rules, shooting sport, fellow shooters, coaches, other office bearers of NRAI and against the policies of Govt. of India/SAI/NRAI.
- r. Must not bring the shooting sport into disrepute through media that relate to tournament officials, technical officials, opposing coaches or team officials and or players, that are personal in nature, imply bias, or question their integrity.
- s. Violation of above may lead to cancellation of entry of this Championship.
