SUB: 2nd DIGVIJAY SINGH MEMORIAL SHOOTING CHAMPIONSHIP IN SHOTGUN EVENTS AT JAIPUR FROM 16th TO 24th DECEMBER 2022.

Dear Sir,

The 2nd Digvijay Singh Memorial Shooting Championship in Shotgun Events will be held at OASES Shooting Ranges, Jagat Pura, Jaipur, Rajasthan, from 16th to 24th December, 2022 as per the program attached at **Annexure "A"**. This will be organized by the National Rifle Association of India and conducted by Rajasthan Rifle Association. The terms and conditions are as under:

1. PARTICIPATION

- a. Shooters who took part in 64/65 NSCC and have achieved MQS in ISSF matches as per rule 17.6 of NRAI Match Book 2022 (amended) are allowed to participate in this Championship. Copy of MQS is attached herewith for your ready reference at **Annexure "B"**
- b. Shooters, who are below 21 years as on 16th December, 2022 will be considered under the category of JUNIORS for the Championship. Juniors, who participated in 65 NSCC in junior category and are above 21 years of age now, will participate in senior category subject to them achieving MQS in junior category during 65 NSCC as per Clause 17.6 of NRAI Match Book 2022 (amended).

2. AGE CRITERIA

- a. Participation in various age category matches will be as per Rule 11 of NRAI Match Book. The age of the shooter (senior, junior, Master and Senior Master) will be calculated from the first day of the competition, (16th December, 2022).
- b. **SHOOTERS BELOW THE AGE OF 12 YEARS AS ON FIRST DAY OF THE COMPETITION ARE NOT ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE DURING THIS CHAMPIONSHIP.**

3. ELIGIBILITY

Shooters qualified, as per Rule 17.6 of NRAI Match Book 2022 (amended) are eligible to participate in this Championship.

Shooters furnishing incorrect information shall be Debarred from taking part in any Shooting championship/competition for Two years including blocking the Shooter ID account

4. ENTRY

List of the individual events is attached herewith as **Annexure "C"**. The entries will be accepted through "NRAI's ONLINE SYSTEM" and no paper entry will be received. These entries will be accepted on confirmation by the respective affiliated State Rifle Association/Units. The Shooters are required to visit our website www.thenrai.org to file their entries along with online payment of entry fee. The online entries with normal fee will be accepted till **6 PM on 8th December, 2022**. Late entries with triple entry fee will be accepted till **6 PM on 10th December, 2022**.

- a) Shooters may contact Mr. Anjan Singh in NRAI office on phone number **011-9555046539** during the working hours for any assistance. Shooters may also send email on email ID indiashooting@gmail.com
- b) Juniors can also participate in senior category with the payment of additional entry fee as per rules.
- c) Entry fee will not be refunded except in the event of the match being cancelled. The entry fee should be paid "online" only and no cash/draft will be accepted.
- d) Shooters will be permitted to shoot only in the squads allotted to them. No requests regarding change of squads will be entertained.

5. TEAM REPRESENTATION

Team events will be conducted in accordance with Rule 18 of NRAI Match Book 2022 (amended). Only one Team from each State/ Unit will be allowed in each event irrespective of the number of participants in National Championship Category. **Final entry of three members of the team must be submitted latest by 14.00 hrs. on the previous day of the start of that particular match as under:**

Trap – 16th December 2022
Skeet – 21st December 2022

6. MIXED TEAM EVENTS

The Mixed Team events will be conducted as per ISSF Rules. All affiliated units which wish to enter must file their entries as under **at NRAI Camp office at Jaipur**. Only one team, consisting of one male and one female of the same state/unit, can be fielded. Entry fee is Rs. 6000/- per team.

Trap Mix Team events before 2 PM on 16th December, 2022
Skeet Mix Team events before 2 PM on 21st December 2022

7. PROTESTS AND APPEALS

The Protests and appeals will be dealt as per ISSF & NRAI Match Book 2022 (amended). The Protest fee is Rs. 200/- and in case of appeal to Jury of Appeal, the protest fee is Rs. 500/-.

8. AMMUNITION

The Rajasthan Rifle Association will provide ammunition to participants against payment. The ammunition will be issued to the Team Manager only against cash payment on valid Arms Licenses of Associations/ Clubs/ Individuals or proper special permit issued by the Licensing Authorities. In case of inadequate authorization, special permits for the required quantity are obtained from the Local Licensing Authorities. Unused rounds and empties of used rounds are to be returned to RRA without any exception. The NRAI members participating in this Competition can also buy ammunition from NRAI office on any working day.

9. GENERAL

- a. In extra ordinary circumstances, the Organizing Secretary may grant permission for use of a common weapon. The names of shooters likely to use common weapon should be advised together with the weapon number to the Organizing Secretary in advance to enable him to work out details for conduct of relevant matches.
- b. All participants are requested to go through the above instructions carefully and ensure strict compliance.
- c. All participants are expected to abide by the rules and regulations for the competition. Discipline on and off the field is very essential.
- d. In case of non-participation by the competitors after submission of their entries will not be allowed any refund of the Entry Fee.
- e. Shooting kit (clothing & Equipment) of the competitors during the competition will be strictly according to ISSF Rules.
- f. Shooting practice in hotels is strictly prohibited.
- g. The Organizers will have the right to close any match or event in case of any emergency or otherwise without assigning any reason for such an action on their part.
- h. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to amend the rules at any time at its sole discretion for events/circumstances beyond its control. Any decision made by the Organizing Committee in any such matter will be final. All participants are expected to abide by the rules and regulations for the competitions. Discipline on and off the field is very essential. Shooting practice in hotels is strictly prohibited.
- i. Scores of this Championship will be considered for selection of International teams under the Selection Policy.
- j. The scores as per score board/computerized score sheet, printed from the centralized scoring system installed at the range and shall only be valid. The Referees are required to make corrections, if any, on spot, during the round well before printing the score sheet. No correction is permissible once the printout has been taken."

k. **COVID PROTOCOLS:**

- i. Due to COVID – 19 conditions, shooters are requested to strictly follow SOPs as laid down by Govt. of India/Delhi Govt.
- ii. All must carry Final Covid Vaccination Certificate with them. In absence of Final Covid Vaccination Certificate, shooters/coaches must undergo a COVID-19 test prior to entering the range for training and submit a negative report from a Govt. certified lab to NRAI. This report should not be older than 48 hours from the date of your first entry at the range.
- iv. Only one person will be allowed to accompany the shooter subject to production of valid negative COVID – 19 reports.

10. **CODE OF CONDUCT**

- a. Be a responsible human being and a committed sports person.
- b. Be respectful towards fellow shooters, officials, Coaches, support staff, Organizers and staff of NRAI.
- c. Be punctual and diligent and adhere schedule timings.
- d. Follow directions by officials.
- e. Shall be dressed appropriately in a dress code prescribed by ISSF.
- f. Be disciplined on and off the field.
- g. Must not verbally abuse or intimidate in any form such as shouting making gesture, towards or in any other way distract any spectator, tournament official, technical official, opposing coach or opposing team official, or opposing player
- h. Shall not indulge in any political or religious and other discourse/discussions.
- i. Should not make any inappropriate or unwanted physical, verbal, or sexual advance towards anyone.
- j. Adhere to rules as set by Govt. of India/Sports Authority of India/State Govt./NRAI or any agency related to the Championship.
- k. Shall abide by the Code of Ethics of ISSF.
- l. Should not consume alcohol or tobacco at range.

- m. It's the responsibility of the shooter to be aware of all the rules and be responsible for their equipment being as per ISSF regulations.
- n. Shooter is responsible for following all rules/norms and go through the notices issued by NRAI at Range/Website of NRAI.
- o. Adhere WADA/NADA rules and not to use drugs, which are not permitted under WADA/NADA rules.
- p. In case of any grievance, please contact the Director of Competition, as per details given below.
- q. Shall not interact with media in any form or over any print/electronic/social platform or post any material, which is contrary to the spirit of IOC Charter, ISSF Rules, shooting sport, fellow shooters, coaches, other office bearers of NRAI and against the policies of Govt. of India/SAI/NRAI.
- r. Must not bring the shooting sport into disrepute through media that relate to tournament officials, technical officials, opposing coaches or team officials and or players, that are personal in nature, imply bias, or question their integrity.
- s. Violation of above may lead to cancellation of entry of this Championship.
