TRAINING FACILITY OPENS AT DR. KARNI SINGH SHOOTING RANGES, NEW DELHI

The training facility is now available at Dr. Karni Singh Shooting Ranges, New Delhi to the shooters who are eligible to participate in Khelo India selection trials (10M Qualification Range). The Shotgun ranges are open for training for the shooters who are eligible to participate in selection trials for ISSF Junior World Cup, Kazakhstan and ISSF Junior World Championship, Lima, Peru.

The terms and conditions for visiting the ranges are as under:

- 1. All the shooters coming for the training and trials may be advised to strictly follow the COVID SOPs as laid down by Govt. of India/SAI/Delhi Govt.
- 2. All the shooters and accompanying person (Limited to 01 for each athlete) should carry a RT PCR Negative report which should not be older than 48 hours from the date of their first entry.
- 3. Accompanying person shall not enter the FOPs.
- 4. Vehicles to be parked in designated area in front of Admin office. However, parent/escorts may drop the athletes along with weapon at the range and return back to the parking area.
- 5. 10M Qualification Range is available for training to shooters for Khelo India from 1.30 PM to 4 PM.
- 6. The shotgun ranges will be available for training from 8.00 am to 1.30 pm.
- 7. Ammunition/air pellets/clay birds are available in NRAI office from Monday, the 5th July 2021 onwards.
