Sub: 44th North Zone Shooting Championship in Shotgun NR Events at Dr. Karni Singh Shooting Ranges, Suraj Kund Road, Tughlakabad, New Delhi from 25th to 31st October, 2025.

The 44th North Zone Shooting Championship 2025 in **Shotgun** events will be held at Dr. Karni Singh Shooting Ranges, Suraj Kund Road, Tughlakabad, New Delhi, **from 25th to 31st October, 2025**. This championship will be conducted by Delhi State Rifle Association under the aegis of the National Rifle Association of India and as per rules and regulations under NRAI Match Book. Those competitors, who want to participate in this competition, are requested to go through the following instructions carefully for their own convenience and to ensure smooth and successful conduct of the above competitions.

This Championship is open to athletes belonging to the States under North Zone only as stated above. Athletes from other States are not permitted to participate in this Championship in any match including for achieving MQS score as Guest Shooter. The athletes from paramilitary forces, AI, ONGC and other affiliated units of NRAI, who are domicile or having posting in the States mentioned above shall be eligible to represent their unit with the prior written permission from NRAI through their unit. Athletes, who have achieved MQS as per Rule 1.4 of NRAI Match Book during State Championship, are allowed to take part in NR Matches only.

Athletes, who are completing the age, as stated below in 2025, will be allowed to participate under age categories matches:

Seniors	Above the age of 21 years
Juniors – 21 years	Born in 2004 or after
Youth - 19 years or before	Born in 2006 or after
Masters – 45 -- 60 years	Should have completed 45 years one day before Competition
Senior Masters – 60 – 70 years	Should have completed 60 years one day before Competition
Super Masters – 70 years	Should have completed 70 years one day before Competition

Youth, Juniors may participate in Senior Category. Similarly, the Super Masters may participate in all age category matches except junior and Youth category. Senior Masters may participate in Masters and Seniors category. Masters can participate in Senior category. Participation in various categories is with the payment of additional entry fee as Per rule.

For Deaf athletes – There will be only one age category – Men and Women. However, Deaf athletes may participate in other category matches according to their age but there no separate medal will be awarded under those categories to Deaf athletes.

For Para athletes - All athletes, who are already registered, are also required to upload their medical categorization certificate as approved by PCI, if not done earlier. Without a medical categorization certificate, no entry will be accepted under Para Category

ATHLETES BELOW THE AGE OF 12 YEARS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN FIRE ARM MATCHES DURING THIS CHAMPIONSHIP.

Athletes, who participated in previous NSCC but failed to achieve MQS under 17.6 of NRAI Match book must file their entry in MQS category failing which they will be disqualified as per Rule 10.6 of NRAI Match book. Athletes, who participated in 66th /67th NSCC and achieved the MQS, as required under the Rule 17.6 of NRAI Match Book are not eligible to participate in National Rule Matches.

FOR EXAMPLE:

- 1. ATHLETES WHO HAVE ALREADY ACHIEVED THE RENOWNED SHOT STATUS IN 66TH OR 67TH NSCC ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN NR MATCHES OF FOR MAVLANKAR/ZONAL CHAMPIONSHIP 2025.**
- 2. ATHLETES WHO HAVE ALREADY PARTICIPATED IN THE NSCC AND HAVE NOT ACHIEVED THE RENOWNED SHOT SCORE, AS PRESCRIBED BY NRAI, THEY WILL HAVE TO COMPETE IN THE MQS CATEGORY.**
- 3. ATHLETES HAVE NOT PARTICIPATED IN ANY NSCC ARE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN NR (INDIVIDUAL)**
- 4. THE PARTICIPANTS OF INDIA OPEN COMPETITION WHO HAVE NOT ACHIEVED CURRENT STATE MQS AS PER RULE 1.4 (OF NRAI MATCH BOOK) ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN AIGVMSC/ZONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS.**

Athletes, who have not received/applied for their Shooter ID number, must immediately visit our website www.thenrai.in to check status/apply for their shooters ID number.

The entries will be accepted through respective affiliated State Rifle Association/Units only. THE ENTRIES WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED ON “NRAI’s ONLINE SYSTEM” and no paper entry will be accepted. The athletes are required to visit our website www.thenrai.org to file their entries along with online payment of entry fee. The online entries with normal fee will be accepted till 7.30 PM on 13th October, 2025. Late entries with triple entry fee will be accepted till 7.30 PM 14th October, 2025.

In case any athlete/Affiliated unit need any assistance for filing the entry, he/she must approach NRAI immediately BUT before 5 PM on 13th October, 2025. so that their entries are accepted with normal fee. athletes contacting for assistance after 14th October, 2025. are liable to pay triple fee. athletes may contact in NRAI office on phone numbers 011-29964091-92-93 during working hours. athletes may also send email on email ID indiashootin@gmail.com

Athletes, who achieved scores as per rule 1.4. Of NRAI Match Book are eligible to participate in this Championship. athletes achieving scores as per rule 17.6 of NRAI Match Book will be allowed to participate in 68th NSCC. Copy of Clause 17.6 is attached herewith for your ready reference.

Entry fee will not be refunded except in the event of the match being cancelled. The entry fee should be paid “online” and no cash/draft will be accepted. athletes will be permitted to shoot only in the details and lanes allotted to them. No requests regarding change of firing points/relays/dates will be entertained. Protest fee is Rs. 500/- (plus 18% GST = Rs.590/-)

A penalty of Rs. 3000/- (plus 18% GST = Rs.3540/- per athlete per event will be imposed on athlete in case athlete’s score is below 15% of the qualifying score as per NRAI Match Book rule 1.4 during the Competition. The State/Unit must recover this amount from the athletes. The State Rifle Association will be responsible for recovery of penalty and deposit the same with NRAI. athletes will not be permitted to participate in any competition till the penalty amount is paid to NRAI.

In case athlete is not qualified in a particular event and adds his/her entry that event on the portal of NRAI, a penalty of Rs. 5000/- (plus 18% GST + Rs.5900/-) shall be imposed on the athlete and will not be allowed to participate in that event. The athlete will be allowed to participate in other events only after payment of penalty amount.

AWARD OF MEDALS

The medals will be awarded in individual category as follows:

- 4 Athletes 3 Medals,
- 3 Athletes 2 Medals,
- 2 Athletes 1 Medal
- 1 Athlete no Medal.

Medals/Badges will not be awarded to those, whose score is less than the qualifying marks as prescribed for the relevant matches irrespective of their individual position. The grading of those securing above the qualifying marks will be done as usual. **This will not apply to the athletes under Deaf, Para, Senior Masters and Super Masters category. (AS PER RULE NO. 10.3 OF NRAI MATCH BOOK)**

Participants using their own arms should be in possession of Valid Arms License.

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to amend the rules at any time at its sole discretion for events/circumstances beyond its control. Any decision made by the Organizing Committee in any such matter will be final. All participants are expected to abide by the rules and regulations for the competitions. Discipline on and off the field is very essential. Shooting practice in hotels is strictly prohibited. Shooting kit (clothing & Equipment) of the competitors during the competition will be strictly according to ISSF Rules.

CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Be a responsible human being and a committed sports person.
2. Be respectful towards fellow shooters, officials, Coaches, support staff and staff of working at ranges
3. Be punctual and diligent and adhere schedule timings.
4. Follow directions by officials.
5. Shall be dressed appropriately in a dress code prescribed by ISSF.
6. Be disciplined on and off the field.
7. Must not verbally abuse or intimidate in any form such as shouting making gesture, towards or in any other way distract any spectator, tournament official, technical official, opposing coach or opposing team official, or opposing player
8. Shall not indulge in any political or religious and other discourse/discussions.
9. Should not make any inappropriate or unwanted physical, verbal, or sexual advance towards anyone.
10. Adhere to rules as set by Govt. of India/Sports Authority of India/NRAI or any agency related to the Championship.
11. Shall abide by the Code of Ethics of ISSF.
12. Should not consume alcohol or tobacco at range.
13. It's the responsibility of the shooter to be aware of all the rules and be responsible for their equipment being as per ISSF regulations.
14. Shooter is responsible for following all rules/norms and go through the notices issued by NRAI at Range/Website of NRAI.
15. Adhere WADA/NADA rules and not to use drugs, which are not permitted under WADA/NADA rules.
16. In case of any grievance, please contact the Director of Competition, as per details given below.

17. Shall not interact with media in any form or over any print/electronic/social platform or post any material, which is contrary to the spirit of IOC Charter, ISSF Rules, shooting sport, fellow shooters, coaches, other office bearers of NRAI and against the policies of Govt. of India/SAI/NRAI.
18. Must not bring the shooting sport into disrepute through media that relate to tournament officials, technical officials, opposing coaches or team officials and or players, that are personal in nature, imply bias, or question their integrity.
19. Violation of above may lead to cancellation of entry of this Championship.
