NATIONAL DEAF SHOOTING CHAMPIONSHIP

1. ORGANISATION

- a) All India Sports Council of the Deaf is the Organisers of the XXV National Deaf Senior Sports Championship & VIII National Deaf Junior & Sub Junior Sports Championship.
- b) AISCD will be including to organise the National Deaf Shooting Championship in Air Rifle and Air Pistol Events in the XXV National Deaf Senior Sports Championship in accordance with ISSF Rules and NRAI Match Book 2022 (amended).

2. VENUE

- a) The Championship will be held at Army Marksmanship Unit (AMU) Shooting Range in Mhow, Madhya Pradesh.

3. SCHEDULE

- a) As per Annexure "A"

4. PARTICIPATION

- a) Participation in the Championship is restricted to shooters who must be deaf, defined as a hearing loss of at least 55dB PTA in the better ear (3-tone frequency average at 500, 1000 and 2000 Hertz, air conduction ISO 1969 Standard).
- b) Open to all Deaf shooters who participated in the 65th NSCC.
- c) Shooters who did not participate in 65th NSCC but have achieved MQS for deaf shooters as per clause 1.4 of NRAI match book (mentioned in table below) in any latest State Championship may also participate in the Competition. Entries of such shooters will be accepted after verification of their audiogram/ Disability Certificate.

5. CLASSIFICATION OF AGE GROUP

- a) The age groups shall be **no-age bar**.

6. CONDUCT OF EVENTS

- a) Events will be conducted as per ISSF Rules
- b) Shooters will have to shoot matches without hearing aids. Hearing aids have to be removed before entering the field of play prior to start of matches.
- c) Finals will be conducted only in events with minimum 08 (eight) participants.

7. LIST OF EVENTS

- a) 10 M. Air Rifle Men
- b) 10 M. Air Rifle Women
- c) 10 M. Air Pistol Men
- d) 10 M. Air Pistol Women

8. ENTRY FEE AND PENALTY FINE

- a) All participants and officials are required to remit non-refundable entry fee of Rs. 1,500.00 (Rupees one thousand and five hundred only) per event to the Council by transfer wire. The Bank Beneficiary Details are attached.
- b) Penalty Fine: Double of entry fee shall be paid as non-starting.

9. SUBMISSION OF ENTRY FORMS

- a) As per the Annexure "B"
- b) Entries submitted in the prescribed forms shall only be accepted. The shooters will print out the entry form, fill it out, scan and send on email to aiscd1965@gmail.com with CC to anujajung@gmail.com before Sunday February 05, 2023.

10. PROTEST AND APPEALS

- a) Protests and appeals will be dealt as per ISSF Rules and NRAI Match Book 2022 (amended). Protest fee is Rs. 200.00 (Rupees two hundred only) and should be filed within 10 (ten) minutes of competition of match and in case of appeal to Jury of Appeal protest fee is Rs. 500.00 (Rupees five hundred only) to be filed within 30 (thirty) minutes.

11. WEAPONS AND PELLETS

- a) Shooters have to bring their own Air Rifles, Air Pistols and Air Pellets. No Air Pellets will be available for purchase at the venue.

12. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- a) Participants are requested to go through above instructions carefully and ensure strict compliance.
- b) Participants are expected to follow rules of the competition strictly and maintain discipline on and off the field.
- c) Entry fees will not be refunded in case of non- participation after submission of entry.
- d) Shooting Kit (Equipment & Clothing) of competitors should be strictly as per ISSF rules.
- e) Shooting practice in place of Accommodation is strictly prohibited. In case of violation disciplinary action will be initiated and shooter may be barred from taking part in the competition.
- f) Accompanying persons/ personal coaches are not allowed to enter field of play.

- g) The organisers will have the right to close any match or event in case of any emergency or otherwise without assigning any reason for such an action on their part.
- h) The organising committee reserves the right to amend the rules at any time at its sole discretion for events/ circumstances beyond their control. Any decision made by the Organising Committee in any such matter will be final All participants are expected to abide by the rules and regulations for the competitions.

13. CODE OF CONDUCT

- a) Be a responsible human being and a committed sportsperson.
- b) Be respectful towards fellow shooters, officials and staff.
- c) Be punctual.
- d) Shall follow directions of the officials.
- e) Shall dress appropriately as per dress code prescribed by ISSF.
- f) Shall not indulge in any kind of verbal abuse, or intimidation in form of shouting, making gesture, or any other form of distraction towards any spectator, official, players or coaches.
- g) Shall not indulge in any political or religious discourse /discussions.
- h) Shall not make any inappropriate or unwanted physical, verbal or sexual advance towards anyone.
- i) Shall not consume alcohol or tobacco in the competition premises.
- j) It is the responsibility of the shooter to be aware of all the rules and be responsible for their equipment being as per ISSF regulations.
- k) Shooter is responsible for following all rules/ norms and go through the notices issued by AISCD/ NRAI.
- l) Adhere to WADA/ NADA rules and not use drugs which are not permitted under WADA/NADA.
- m) In case of any grievance contact the director of competitions as per details given below.
- n) Shall not interact with media in any form or over any print/ electronic/ social platform or post any material which is contrary to the spirit of IOC Charter, ISSF rules, shooting sport, fellow shooters, coaches other office bearers of AISCD or NRAI and against policies of the Government of India.
- o) Shall not bring shooting sport into disrepute through media that relate to tournament officials, technical officials, opposing coaches or team officials and or players that are personal in nature, imply bias or question their integrity.
- p) Violation of the above may lead to cancellation of entry of this championship.
- q) Shooters may contact the Director of Competition for any further information details that maybe required by them and might not have been covered by the above instructions.

14. FOOD & ACCOMMODATION

- a) All the shooters and accompanying Coach-cum-Managers (for the prescribed number only) shall be provided with free boarding & lodging during the Games.
- b) No observer or parents shall be allowed.
- c) All shooters and managers must bring their own bed sheet / blanket and personal items.
- d) The mess will open with the lunch on 16th February, 2023 and will close with the breakfast on 19th February, 2023.

- e) Teams / Competitors (including accompanying officials) who have lost their match / event and having no more match / item to complete in the Championship can leave the camp, if they desire so, with the permission of the Organising Secretary. List of such competitors must be submitted to the Organising Secretary by the Manager / Head of the concerned State team.

15. PRIZES & AWARDS

- a) Gold, Silver and Bronze Medals and Certificate of Merit will be presented to I, II and III place winners, respectively.
b) Certificate of Participation will be awarded to all participants by the Hosts.
