ADVISORY FOR PARRICIPATION IN 65 NATIONAL SHOOTING CHAMPIONSHIP COMPETITIONS (NSCC) 2022

1. All affiliated units must appoint their manager for smooth conduct of the NSCC. Shooters are requested to contact RTS office/NRAI through their State Manager only.

2. Shooters, desirous of participating in 65 NSCC, are advised to go through the NRAI Match Book and respective circulars for participation details before sending any email to NRAI. The NRAI Match Book and circulars are available on NRAI website <u>www.thenrai.in</u>

3. After filing entries, shooters should check their Login Profile. In case of any difficulty, please contact NRAI. Shooter must quote their name, date of birth, State and name of the Competition, they are participating so that their transaction is tracked. It takes around 72 hours to process the entry through respective State Rifle Associations/Units. Shooters are requested not to send emails immediately after filing their entries. No such emails will be responded.

4. IF ENTRIES ARE APPROVED, THE COMPETITIOR CARDS CAN BE DOWNLOADED AFTER 5th NOVEMBER 2022 BY VISITING NRAI WEBSITE www.thenrai.in/www.thernai.org

5. Detail adjustment can be done amongst the shooters of the same State/Unit and through State Rifle Associations/Units only. Shooters desirous of detail adjustment should contact to their State/unit and do not send any email to NRAI. Such emails will not be responsed. Affiliated units are requested to send us a consolidated list of shooters, who wish to change their details due to their exams. The Affiliated Units must ensure that the requests of genuine cases are forwarded to NRAI. ALL CONSOLIDATED REQUESTS MUST BE SENT TO NRAI **BEFORE 17TH NOVEMBER 2022**. EMAILS SENT IN PIECEMEAL WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED. No such email will be entertained nor replied to by NRAI.

6. GUN CARRY LETTER – The shooters may download Gun Carry Letter from our website <u>www.thenrai.org</u> if travelling by air. The gun carry letter can be downloaded after approval of the entry. In case of travelling with more than one weapon or more than 50 rounds of ammunition, shooters must apply for DGCA permit through the online service of DGCA.

7. TEAM AND MIX TEAM ENTRIES – Affiliated units are advised to adhere to the deadlines fixed for filing the Team entries (through ONLINE SYSTEM) and Mix Team Event (at competition venue on 20th November 2022). Mix Team entries will be accepted through Team Manager. Last dates for filing Team entries are mentioned in Circulars.

8. Parents/Personal coaches are advised to contact NRAI only through their Team Manager. Parents/Personal coaches are not permitted to enter Field of Play (FOP) and may remain in the spectator area. Violation of any incident may lead to disqualification of the shooter from this NSCC.

9. Due to low demand of air pellets from shooters at venues, no air pellets will be available for sale. State Rifle Associations are requested to procure the pellets from the NRAI office. Similarly, those shooters, who are Life/Annual Members of NRAI, can purchase air pellets from NRAI Office on any working day. Ammunition of .22 and .32 caliber ammunition will be available and can be collected by the Team Managers against valid arm licenses. The affiliated units are requested to ensure that the Managers are in possession of valid arm licenses with adequate authorization to purchase ammunition.
