SUB: XXI KUMAR SURENDRA SINGH MEMORIAL SHOOTING CHAMPIONSHIP IN RIFLE EVENTS AT VATTIYOOKKAVU, THIRUVANANTHAPURAM, KERALA FROM 4th to 16th JUNE 2023.

Dear Sir,

The XXI Kumar Surendra Singh Memorial Shooting Championship in Rifle events will be held at Shooting Range, Vattiyoorkkavu, Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala from 4th to 16th June 2023 as per the program attached at **Annexure “A”**. This will be organized and conducted by the National Rifle Association of India. Shooters from your State/Unit are invited to participate in this Championship. The terms and conditions are as under:

1. Shooters who took part in 64th NSCC/65th NSCC and have achieved qualifying score as per rule 17.6 of NRAI Match Book are allowed to participate in this Championship. Copy of MQS is attached herewith for your ready reference at **Annexure “B”**.

2. PARTICIPATION, MATCHES, ENTRY FORM & FEE

a. Participation is open to competitors from State Rifle Associations/ Units affiliated to NRAI as stated under para 1 above. NRAI members must take part through State Rifle Associations/ Units of their native place otherwise their entry will not be accepted. However, if there is no such Association / Club functioning in their State, they can take part as members of NRAI provided they have paid all their dues towards NRAI. State Rifle Associations/Units will allow the members of NRAI to participate in the competitions organized by NRAI without becoming a member of that State/Club to which he/she belongs subject to the member undertaking to follow all the rules and regulations applicable to the shooters of that State. The State Rifle Associations/units may also charge an additional fee equal to entry fee of the competition but not more than Rs. 5000/- for forwarding the entries of Life/Annual Members of NRAI. This is applicable when these shooters are not members of State/Unit or any District/club to which Members of NRAI wish to represent. The Members of NRAI must have achieved MQS as defined for each competition under NRAI Match Book 2022.

b. The competition will be conducted in individual and in team events. There will be no team event in junior/youth/veteran/foreign national category. Shooters, who have taken part on wild card entry cannot be the member of teams. Furnishing wrong information in this regard would attract disqualification of team. Teams can be formed by the shooters of the same State/Unit only. Final entry of three members of the team must be submitted **online** latest by 17.00 hours on the previous day of the start of the match. Only one team per State/Unit will be allowed in each event. The competition will be conducted in the events as per **Annexure “C”**.

- c. The entries will be accepted from respective affiliated State Rifle Association/Units through “NRAI’s ONLINE SYSTEM” and no paper entry will be accepted. The Shooters are required to visit our website www.thenrai.org to file their entries along with online payment of entry fee. The online entries with normal fee will be accepted till **07.30 PM on 15th May 2023**. Late entries with triple entry fee will be accepted till 07.30 PM on 17th May 2023.

- e. Shooters, who are completing the age, as stated below in 2023, will be allowed to participate under age categories matches:

Juniors – 21 years	Born in 2002 or above.
Youth – 19 years or below	Born in 2004 or above.
Sub Youth – 16 years or below	Born in 2007 or above.
Masters – between 45 – 60 years	Born in 1963 – 1978.
Senior Masters – 61 – 70 years	Born in 1953 – 1962.
Super Masters – 71 years	Born in 1952 or below

SHOOTERS BELOW THE AGE OF 12 YEARS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN FIRE ARM MATCHES DURING THIS CHAMPIONSHIP.

- f. Foreign Nationals must part in matches, specifically for Foreign Nationals and are not permitted to participate in matches for Indian Nationals. In case of any violation, the shooter will be disqualified from participation in this Championship. The list of matches is attached at **Annexure “D”**.
- g. The shooters are requested to download their competitor card/Equipment Control Sheet from our website www.thenrai.org as the same will not be issued at the shooting range.

3. Scores achieved by the shooters during this Championship will be considered for selection of international teams as per Selection Criteria.

4. Shooters taking part in Rifle event are not allowed to take part in Pistol event or vice versa.
5. Finals will be conducted in all Olympic events for SENIORS, JUNIORS and YOUTH.

6. MIXED EVENTS

The Mixed Air Rifle events will be conducted as per ISSF Rules. All affiliated units which wish to enter must file their entries before **2 PM on 4th June 2023** Only one team, consisting of one male and one female of the same state/unit, can be fielded. Entry fee is Rs. 2000/- (plus 18% GST = Rs.2360/-) per team. **Shooters participating on Wild Card entry cannot be member of any team.**

7. Individual and Team medals will be awarded as under:-

- I 3 medals where there is a minimum of 4 entries.
- II 2 medals where there is a minimum of 3 entries.
- III 1 medal where there is a minimum of 2 entries.
- IV No medal in case there is a singly entry.
- V Foreign Nationals may be awarded souvenirs

Senior and Super master’s category shooters are exempted from above.

8. Protest fee is Rs. 200/- (plus 18% GST = Rs.236/-) and in case an appeal is filed with the Jury of Appeal, then the fee is Rs. 500/- (plus 18% GST = Rs.590/-). The fee will be returned if the protest is upheld and retained by the Organizers if the protest is lost.
9. The competition will be conducted according to ISSF rules and regulations.
10. No arms will be provided to the competitors by NRAI. Ammunition will be made available against payment.
11. The Organizers will have the right to close any match or event in case of any emergency or otherwise without assigning any reason for such an action on their part.
12. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to amend the rules at any time at its sole discretion for events/circumstances beyond its control. Any decision made by the Organizing Committee in any such matter will be final. All participants are expected to abide by the rules and regulations for the competitions. Discipline on and off the field is very essential. Shooting practice in hotels is strictly prohibited.
13. In case of non-participation by the competitors after submission of their entries will not be allowed any refund of the Entry Fee.
14. No request for any adjustment shall be entertained. The time and details will be notified on the website of NRAI. Shooters are required to enter the range 90 minutes before the reporting time at range so that they can report on time for their detail.

15. COVID PROTOCOLS:

i. Due to COVID – 19 conditions, shooters are requested to strictly follow SOPs as laid down by Govt. of India/KERALA Govt.

ii. Only one person will be allowed to accompany the shooter.

16. The shooters/officials may contact the undersigned for any further information/details that may be required by them and might have not been covered by the above instructions.
