The following amendments/additions are approved by the Governing Body of NRAI during its meeting held on 26th February 2022 in Selection Criteria of Rifle and Pistol events:

- A. Shooters who are participating in ISSF World Cup, Cairo
 - 1. Score of 64 NSCC will considered as first score
 - 2. Score of ISSF WC, Cairo will be considered as second score.
 - 3. For the purpose of third score, a shooter is required to participate at least in one Selection trial (1 or 2), which are being conducted at Bhopal. Total of 3 scores will be divided by 3 to arrive at the average/ranking under Stage 1.
 - 4.In case a shooter wishes to participate in both the trials, then the total of four scores will be divided by 4 to arrive at average/ranking under Stage 1.
 - 5. It is clarified that the fourth score (trial 2 score) for the shooters participating in ISSF World Cup, Cairo will be considered under Stage 1.
- B. Selection Criteria amended as on 26.02 2022 (necessitated by the postponement of Selection trial 1 & 2 due to the pandemic)
 - 1). Every Shooter must have at least one score in a recognised competition in Every Stage. That is; even if the shooter has the minimum scores required for each stage it would be mandatory for him / her to shoot at least one match in a recognised competition in every stage. For e.g. World Cup participants may have 4 scores before the commencement of stage 2 s / he would still be required to shoot at least one match in stage 2 for the purpose of ranking.
 - 2). A shooter who has one score equal to or above the MTS in the relevant stage or an Average of the MTS(stated in Chart Y) would be eligible to participate in the World Cups.
- C. The ISSF has introduced a new format of 50M Rifle 3P match with Elimination and Qualification rounds of 60 shot match instead of 120 shot match. Since the schedule of the 50M Rifle 3P match for Men and Women for Trials 1 & 2 was already announced, it was decided that only the Qualification Round with 60 shot matches, followed by Finals, will be conducted at Bhopal. The decision to conduct Elimination and Qualification for further competitions will be considered from Stage 2.

- D. The 50M Rifle 3P Match was conducted with 120 shots during 64 NSCC and all the shooters have the score in this match out of 120 shots. The ISSF has introduced a new format with 60 shots in said match. There would be a disparity at the time of calculation of average with a score out of 120 shots and with the subsequent scores (score of ISSF World Cup, Cairo and Bhopal Trial scores) with 60 shots. In view of this, it has been decided that the score of 64 NSCC in 50M Rifle 3P (for Men and Women) will be divided by 2 to bring parity amongst all scores.
- E. The Semi Finals of Air Rifle and Air Pistol will be conducted simultaneously and not separately amongst shooters ranked 1,3,5,7 and 2,4,6,8
